Message from Fr Tony Hesse:

As I mentioned last weekend and as you see by my being gone this weekend, I along with 25 others (13 from our AFC), are on a pilgrimage to Medjugorje, Fatima, and Lourdes to receive whatever graces the good Lord, through Mary, wants to offer us. Although these places are known for Marian apparitions, and people have experienced spiritual renewal, found peace, received healing, deepened their faith, and connected with God, my hope is to receive whatever they are willing to share with us. I also hope to experience opportunities for reflection, prayer, community with other believers, and personal transformation to be who God is calling me to be.

Medjugorje, Bosnia-Herzegovina: In 1981, six visionaries reported seeing the Virgin Mary. Pilgrims visit sites like Apparition Hill and Cross Mountain for prayer and spiritual renewal. The apparitions here are seen as a continuation of the messages from Fatima, urging prayer, fasting, and a return to God.

Fatima, Portugal: In 1917, the Virgin Mary appeared to three shepherd children. The site features a sanctuary and a significant candlelight procession where pilgrims pray the Rosary. Pilgrims are drawn to the site by the messages of peace, prayer, and conversion from Our Lady. Lourdes, France: In 1858, the Virgin Mary appeared to a young girl named Bernadette Soubirous in a grotto. The site is known for its healing spring water, where pilgrims visit the grotto of Massabielle, drink the water, and bathe in it. Visitors come for spiritual healing and cleansing, participating in Mass, processions, and prayers.

I have never been to any of these sites, but am looking forward to whatever God has in store for us. By the way, if you are interested in more info on these sites, please check out Formed. If you have not gone on Formed, there is more info on "how-to" in the bulletin. I look forward to sharing what I experienced when we get back. Know of my thoughts and prayers and if you were unable to get intentions for us, don't worry. Just turn them to Mary and we will offer up any intentions that are still accumulating. May God bless you all through Our Lady!


