## Message from Fr Tony Hesse:

---

Next weekend, we will be taking up a 2nd collection to help the people in Gaza and the Middle East (see more information on page 6). However, we also will be celebrating at the 6pm Mass the Confirmation and Eucharist of a few young ladies (Sara Bailey, Chloe Kahley, Hailey Mohr, and Kayla Rohlik) through the OCIA process. The OCIA (Order of Christian Initiation of Adults) process is a period of faith formation for adults seeking to join the Catholic Church through baptism and other sacraments, or for Catholics to complete their initiation. The process involves periods of learning, prayer, discussion, and reflection, culminating in the reception of the sacraments of Baptism, Confirmation, and Eucharist, typically at the Easter Vigil.

This process, restored by the Second Vatican Council, follows the ancient practices of the Church and helps individuals on their journey of conversion and full membership in the community. The process also involves several periods for learning about Catholic teachings and practices, various liturgical celebrations, with some requiring the participation of the candidate's sponsor or godparent (we had the Rite of Welcoming a few weeks ago at St. Anne), candidates being accompanied by a sponsor or godparent who supports them in their spiritual journey, and the process emphasizes the experience of living faith within the parish community.

However, because these four have already been baptized, we are able to celebrate it outside of the Easter Vigil and tweak it so that the process applies to them. The OCIA process serves several purposes: (1) For adults seeking full membership: adults who want to become Catholic, whether they are unbaptized or baptized in another Christian faith; (2) For incomplete Catholic initiation: Catholics who were baptized as infants but never received their First Communion, Confirmation, or subsequent religious education; (3) For those exploring the faith: people to learn about the Catholic faith and discern their calling to the Church.

Please keep these four in your prayers as well as our youth as we begin another Faith Formation Program this week. Also, if you are ever interested in being Catholic or completing your initiation process, let us know as well.

## Humanitarian Crisis in Gaza

WASHINGTON – “The situation in Gaza and across the Middle East cries out for the assistance of the Catholic community of the United States,” said Archbishop Timothy P. Broglio, president of the U.S. Conference of Catholic Bishops (USCCB). In a letter to the U.S. bishops, he asked them to consider taking up a voluntary special collection in their dioceses, if they are able, to support the efforts of Catholic Relief Services (CRS) and the Catholic Near East Welfare Association (CNEWA). Both organizations have well-established partnerships with the Catholic Church in the region to allow them to respond quickly and efficiently.

“Our Church mourns the terrible suffering of Christians and other innocent victims of violence in Gaza and surrounding areas who are struggling to survive, protect their children, and live with dignity in dire conditions,” continued Archbishop Broglio. “The Holy Father continues to call for a cease fire and for aid to enter the territory, noting with great sorrow that ‘Gaza is starving,’” and encouraged the bishops to consider the special collection in their dioceses at their earliest opportunity.



## WE DID IT • Capital Campaign New St. Anne's School Goal Achieved!

Thanks to the financial generosity of many individuals, families, small businesses, and other supportive groups, we have reached (and exceeded) our new school capital campaign financial goal of \$12,223,594. As of September 3, the amount of pledges raised is now \$12,461,852.

We have created a New School Building Committee that includes Father Tony Hesse, Mary Franta, Paul Daub, Bruce Plaetz, Bruce Johnson, Dan Baune, and Tim Lipestsky. The Building Committee has begun working with our architect, Richard Engan from Engan Associates in Willmar, to begin the detailed design, review current cost estimates, and to look for ways we can value engineer the building to gain the most efficient space for the dollars expended. We must be very careful stewards of these funds, since they were given with the trust and hope that the Building Committee could obtain the best value for each dollar spent for the project.

Our target is now to collect the remaining pledged funds (\$683,181) and put the project out for bid before year end 2025 (well ahead of schedule), with the intent to lock in pricing and break ground next April 2026.

Although we have exceeded our original financial goal, we feel it is important to build up a “cushion/reserve fund” in the event of cost increases beyond our original estimate and to enhance the building square footage and/or amenities as the project moves forward.

How can you help? We welcome your additional financial contributions (or post-harvest agricultural commodities) to ensure that there is no shortfall in funding for genuine unforeseen needs. As we have stated in the past, we pledge to build an accessible, functional, and practical school building to serve our children and grandchildren for decades to come. Thank you for your continued confidence, prayers, and financial support!
