1 DIVINE MERCY

2 HOLY FAMILY

8 ST. CARLO ACUTIS



— St. Carlo Acutis is a millennial saint who was devoted to bringing God's word to young people and reminds us that people today can become saints.

9 ST. LEO (L.eonard, E.lizabeth, O.ur Lady of Victory)



— In honor of our first American Pope and the many St. Leo's, LEO can also stand for Leonard, Elizabeth and Our Lady of Victory.
