

HYALURONIDASE

Pre-Treatment Guidelines

- Discontinue Blood Thinners: Stop taking aspirin, ibuprofen, vitamin E, fish oil, or other blood-thinning medications 3–5 days prior to treatment, unless medically necessary. Consult your healthcare provider before discontinuing any prescribed medications.
- No Alcohol: Refrain from consuming alcohol for at least 24 hours before treatment to minimize the risk of bruising.
- Avoid Smoking: Stop smoking for at least 24 hours before the procedure to promote better healing.
- Cold Sore History: Notify your provider if you have a history of cold sores (herpes simplex virus), as antiviral medication may be necessary to prevent an outbreak.
- Hydration: Drink plenty of water before the treatment to keep your skin hydrated and promote optimal healing.
- Avoid Treatment if Pregnant or Breastfeeding:
 Hyaluronidase is not recommended for individuals who are pregnant or breastfeeding. Notify your provider if this applies to you.
