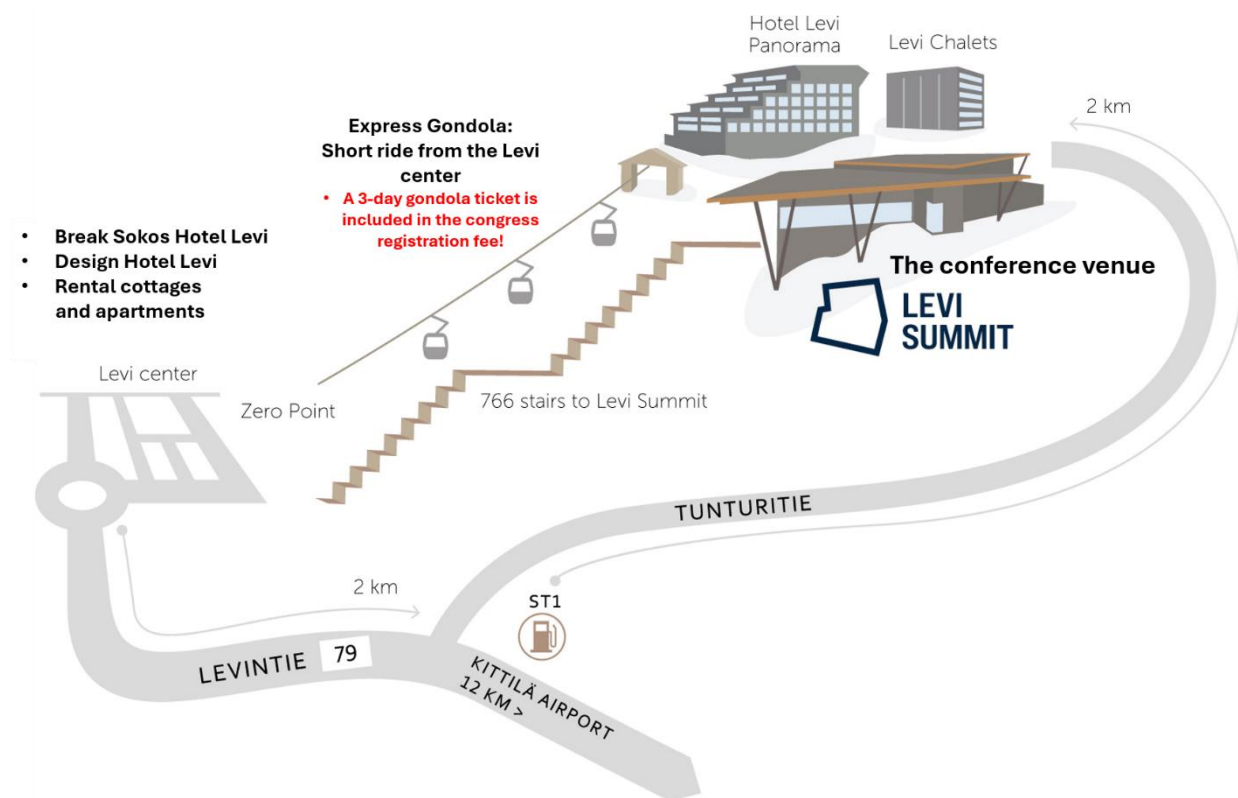

The AE-PCOS Meeting 2026 will be held in Levi, Finland. The meeting starts on December 10th at 9 am and ends on December 12th at 2:45 pm.

The meeting will be held at the Levi Summit Conference Center, located on the front slope of the fell next to the Panorama Hotel. The venue can be reached quickly and easily via a scenic gondola lift from the Levi village, where various accommodation options are available for the conference guests. The gondola fee for three days is covered in the registration fee.





Levi is one of Finland's most iconic winter destinations, located in the heart of Finnish Lapland, north of the Arctic Circle. Surrounded by pristine wilderness, snow-covered fells and breathtaking Arctic scenery, Levi offers a truly unforgettable setting for the AE-PCOS Meeting.

In December, Levi is wrapped in the enchanting polar night. While the sun does not rise above the horizon, the landscape is illuminated by the magical blue twilight, creating a unique and serene atmosphere. On clear nights, the sky comes alive with thousands of stars and, if you are lucky, the spectacular Northern Lights dancing overhead. Whilst enjoying them, you can enjoy the cleanest drinking water in the world.

Levi combines authentic Lapland charm with excellent infrastructure. As one of Finland's most popular winter resorts and the annual host of an Alpine Skiing World Cup race, Levi offers high-quality services, cozy accommodation and a vibrant yet compact village where everything is within easy walking distance. A convenient SkiBus operates around the fell, making it effortless to explore the area. The Christmas season in Lapland is filled with wonder, beauty and unforgettable moments – the perfect backdrop for both professional exchange and extraordinary experiences.

Kittilä Taxis

Taxis operating in the Kittilä area are available at the taxi stand in front of the airport according to flight schedules. If you want to ensure a ride or have special requests, you can book a taxi in advance.

The taxi stand serving passengers is located to the left of the terminal's main entrance. Pre-booked taxis serve passengers on the right side of the terminal doors. All taxis operating in the Kittilä Airport taxi area have a cooperation agreement with Finavia.

Congress Venue – Levi Summit

The Ae PCOS Meeting will be held at **Levi Summit conference Centre which is in contact with the Panorama Hotel**. The Levi Summit is a modern congress centre located on the front slope of the fell. 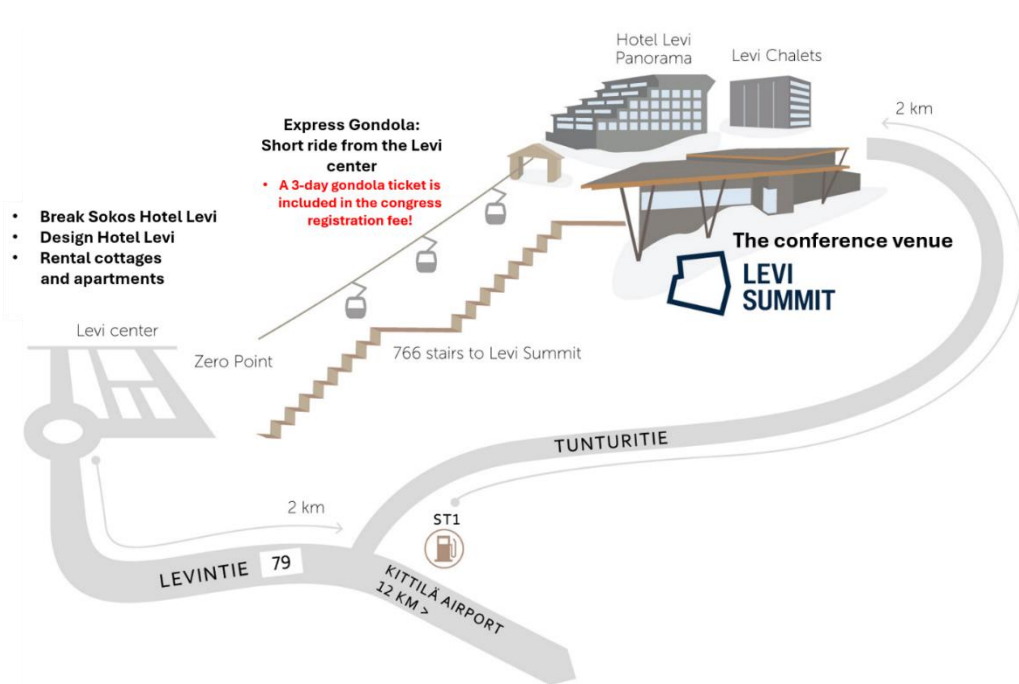

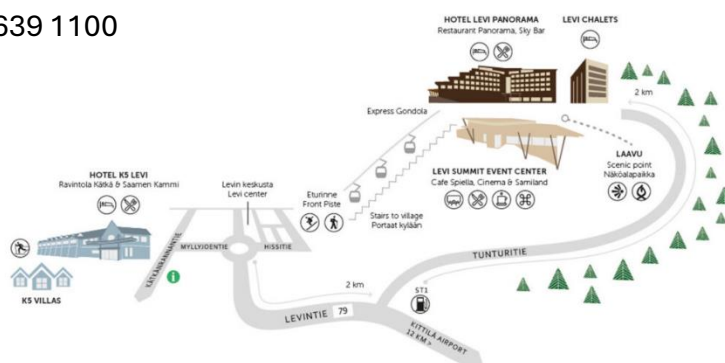

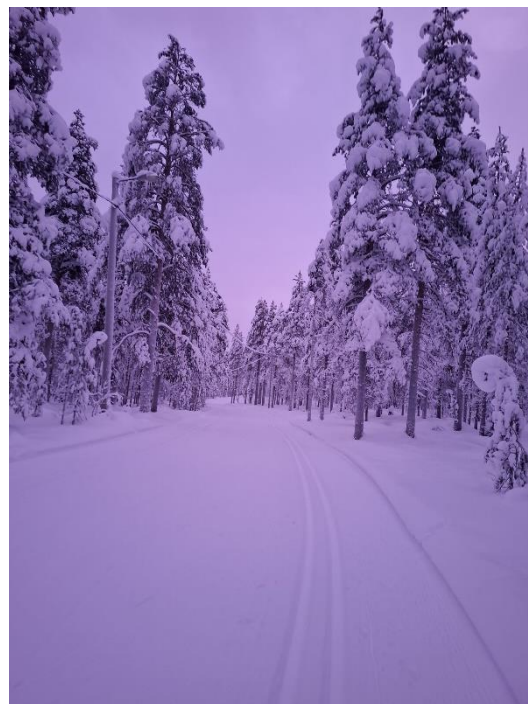
Activities – Discover the Arctic Winter

Lapland weather in December

The weather in Levi in December is typically freezing, averaging around -7°C during the day and -14°C at night (approx. 19°F during the day, 7°F at night), but temperatures can drop significantly colder, even tens of degrees below zero, and there is often a lot of snow. Later tips on how to dress.



Dressing for Winter in Lapland

December in Levi means true Arctic winter – crisp air, snow-covered landscapes and magical light. With the right clothing, winter in Lapland is not only comfortable but truly enjoyable.

Good news: you do not need special expedition gear. Layered clothing and common winter wear are perfectly sufficient.

We recommend dressing in layers:

- **Base layer:** thermal underwear (wool or technical material) to keep you warm and dry
- **Mid layer:** a fleece, wool sweater or light down jacket for insulation
- **Outer layer:** a warm winter coat and windproof trousers
- **Accessories:** a warm hat, scarf, gloves or mittens
- **Footwear:** insulated, waterproof winter boots with good grip

Indoor spaces, including the congress venue, hotels, restaurants and shops, are well heated. Winter clothing can easily be left in cloakrooms or hotel lobbies when indoors.

For outdoor activities such as Northern Lights excursions, husky rides or snowmobile safaris, **all necessary thermal equipment is typically provided by the activity organizers**, including overalls, boots and gloves.

Local shops in Levi also offer a wide selection of winter clothing and accessories should you wish to purchase or upgrade gear during your stay.

With proper clothing, the Arctic winter becomes a unique and memorable part of the Levi experience – fresh, peaceful and beautifully inspiring.



Where to Rent or Buy

Winterent Clothing Rental Levi – Stylish and reliable winter clothing sets for adults and kids. They include a warm insulated jacket, winter trousers, snow mittens, waterproof snow boots and a cozy tube scarf — ideal for the cold Arctic outdoor conditions. Delivery and pickup services are available to your accommodation for extra convenience.

You can also check with Levi tourist information (the local tourist information centre) for the latest rental services and seasonal offers around town. Reserve your clothing in advance, especially during peak winter season — Levi gets busy around December.
