DAY 2 (Thursday 25)

IT'S SANTA'S DAY!!

We start our special day with breakfast then pack up a picnic lunch (included) and head to **Paihia** in the beautiful Bay of Islands. On our arrival you will have time to enjoy this popular destination at your leisure. We have included a **return ferry ticket to Russell**, *the first permanent European settlement which soon earned a reputation as a community full of prostitution and without laws. It became known as the "Hell Hole of the Pacific"*; it is now well known for its many cafes & holiday homes. Take time to view Pompallier Mission House (unfortunately closed today but can be viewed from outside), the historic printery/tannery/storehouse of the early Roman Catholic missionaries, is the oldest surviving industrial building in New Zealand, while the town's Christ Church is the country's oldest surviving Anglican church, see if you can see the bullet holes from the Battle of Kororareka in 1845. After we have had time to relax and wander we will return to Whangarei where there will be some free time to explore the area, visit friends or enjoy the pool. Tonight we enjoy a special Christmas Dinner. If we are really good Father Christmas may even visit us at some time during the day.

DAY 3 (Friday 26)

After a hearty breakfast we start our day with a scenic drive to Dargaville where we visit the **Dargaville Museum** which tells the fascinating stories of the Kauri Coast: from early Maori life represented by the 16-metre pre-European waka, the replica gumdiggers camp, shipwreck relics recovered from Ripiro Beach to the masts of the ill-fated Greenpeace protest ship, the Rainbow Warrior. Take time wander outside and take in the magnificent views overlooking

the district, town and the Northern Wairoa River. Today we enjoy **lunch at the historic Northern Wairoa Hotel** (included). Upon our return to Whangarei we visit the **Whangarei Falls,** a picturesque 26.3 metre waterfall with easy walking tracks, before returning to the hotel where you will have time to rest and relax before dinner.

DAY 4 (Saturday 27)

Today we farewell Whangarei but not before enjoying a **cruise on the Whangarei Harbour** starting at the Town Basin where many international vessels are moored, under the Bascule Bridge past Kissing Point Boatshed before returning to the Town Basin. Then you have some free time where you may like to visit Claphams Clocks, The Hundertwasser Art Centre, take time to wander the marina, visit the craft shops in the area and sample one of the many cafes for lunch (all at own cost). We then re-group and travel to **Kiwi North** for a self-guided visit see native species including geckos & kiwi (feeding at 3pm), early settler collections at the Whangarei Museum, and Heritage Park and beautiful grounds.

We then commence our journey southward through Waipu, Kaiwaka until we see the Auckland sky-line and our home for the final night of our Merry Xmas Tour.

This evening there is time to reflect on a delightful day and enjoy a relaxing evening with all our new found friends.
