

Tuesday 29 October

New Plymouth - Picton

We depart New Plymouth this morning and travel South through the Taranaki farmlands to the River City of Wanganui. Travelling on we pass through the rich farm lands of the lower North Island and follow the Kapiti Coast for some distance before arriving in Wellington. We board the ferry to cross Cook Strait and cruise the beautiful Queen Charlotte Sound before arriving in Picton.

Wednesday 30 October

Picton - Collingwood

Departing Blenheim we travel to Havelock, the Greenshell Mussel Captial of the world and the gateway to the Pelorus & Kenepuru Sounds, the lovely area of Pelorus Bridge through the Rai Valley to Nelson. We then commence our journey around Tasman Bay through the old tobacco growing regions of Motueka & Riwaka to cross the Takaka Hill (New Zealand's Marble Mountain) to Takaka where we capture our first glimpse of Golden Bay and Collingwood in the distance. There will be some interesting stops along the way today and some lovely scenery as we pass by Abel Tasman National Park and the Bays.

Thursday 31 October

Farewell Spit Day Tour

This morning we have time to explore Collingwood and enjoy lunch (included), before joining a specialist tour operator approved by DOC to enjoy a sightseeing tour of Farewell Spit and the unique scenery and nature of this delightful area. Visit Cape Farewell (the most northern point on the South Island), from the cliff top seals and their pups can be seen basking on the rocks. We travel for approx. 30 kms along the ocean beach to the lighthouse where we pause. Take time to learn about the unique families that lived and worked here in days gone by. On our return there are more scenic stops—a day to be enjoyed by all.

Friday 1 November

Collingwood to Westport

Leaving Collingwood and our hosts we once again pass over the Takaka Hill through the old tobacco growing regions of Riwaka & Motueka and over the Hope Saddle to the earthquake town of Murchison. We then travel through the scenic Buller Gorge and on to Westport (home for 2 nights). During the day we will take time to make interesting stops.

Saturday 2 November

Karamea Day Trip

We enjoy a tour today to visit Denniston, take a step back in time with Gary & Sylvia at the Friends of the Hill Museum where they tell stories so we can start to imagine what life was like living 'on the hill' in the late 1800's and working the famous Denniston rail incline. It is then through the little town of Granity as we continue our scenic drive as far north as the historic town of Karamea. During the day we learn some of the local history of the area and take a step back in time. (Lunch is included).

Sunday 3 November

Westport to Christchurch

We bid Westport farewell this morning as we journey south where we follow the stunning coast-line and beech clad hillsides through the small coastal settlements that will see us arrive in Greymouth and on through to Kumara Junction where we turn onto the Arthur's Pass Road. There are many interesting and photographic places to stop today as we cross Arthur's Pass and Porters Pass, going from the mixed rainforests of Westland, the snow and ice of the Main Divide, the tawny tussocklands surrounded by scree-sloped mountains, and the fertile flats and broad shingle beds of Canterbury. Christchurch is our home for the night.
