**NSN Global Services Bolsters Cyber Defenses and Prepares for Post-Conflict Youth Development Amid Middle East Volatility.**

Note: To date, no NSN systems or services have been affected. NSN Global Services condemns attacks on civilian infrastructure.

Following recent large-scale developments in Iran as of Tuesday, March 3, 2026 and reported retaliatory actions across the region, including strikes on civilian data centers operated by U.S. companies, NSN Global Services is alerting stakeholders to heightened risks of cyber threats. Iranian state-sponsored actors and affiliated hacker groups are known to respond asymmetrically through cyberattacks targeting critical infrastructure worldwide. NSN Global Services sometimes uses third-party data centers across multiple continents which could face increased risks of disruption.

To address these threats, NSN Global Services is implementing several key measures to strengthen its digital defenses and ensure continuity of business operations including:

1. **Enhanced Cybersecurity Protocols:** We are reviewing advanced threat detection systems, zero-trust architecture across all networks, multi-layered encryption, and real-time monitoring. Regular penetration testing and cybersecurity specific reviews are underway in collaboration with the company's cybersecurity agency partners and third-party providers.
2. **Data Center Resilience:** Geographic diversification of infrastructure is being considered in the event that services are affected to ensure continued running of operations.
3. **Resource Reallocation:** In alignment with our mission to improve education systems and empower youth populations globally, resources are being redirected to protect NSN interests. We are developing comprehensive contingency plans to rapidly resume and expand youth education and technology initiatives; including digital literacy, technological innovation, and workforce development once tensions in the conflict zone(s) subside. Our goal is to support reconstruction efforts by fostering opportunity, optimism, and skill-building for the next generation in a more stabilized Middle East.

“NSN Global Services remains committed to our core mission of advancing education and technology for a better world including across the Middle East. Our missions and interests in the region will not be held back by this conflict long-term, but services may be temporarily affected if key data infrastructure is targeted in the region. We are taking action to review all cybersecurity protections due to the increased threats against Western companies, although no issues have directly affected our services thus far,” said Euan Hallifax, Founder and CEO. “By fortifying our digital infrastructure and preparing strategically with ongoing cybersecurity reviews, we ensure we can continue delivering impactful programs that build resilient communities long after the conflict subsides.”

NSN Global Services continues to monitor the situation closely around strikes on Middle Eastern third-party data centers which could affect services if targeted, and will provide updates as required.
