## **NSN Safer Living – Campaign Overview and Pledge**

### **Last updated – March 2026**

Welcome to NSN Safer Living. A Joint US-UK Initiative for Youth Safety and Well-Being.

NSN Safer Living is a voluntary awareness and partnership movement initiated by NSN Global Services, building on our long-standing mission to improve education systems, workforce development, and opportunities for young people worldwide. With roots in the United States (Dover, Delaware) and the United Kingdom (via National Student Networks), and through our subsidiary NSN OneWorld's focus on empowering youth in developing regions, we extend our commitment to creating optimistic, opportunity-rich futures for the next generation.

This initiative addresses real-world challenges faced by students and young adults in everyday settings — particularly in educational environments, social gatherings, and nightlife. By promoting proactive health education, crime prevention awareness, and community collaboration, NSN Safer Living seeks to foster environments where young people can thrive safely.

### **Where NSN Support Goes**

NSN Global Services supports NSN Safer Living through:

- Development and provision of free or low-cost educational resources and awareness materials.
- Facilitation of partnerships, workshops, and information-sharing networks among signatories, educational institutions, businesses, and community groups.
- Advocacy for evidence-based practices in youth safety, drawing from our global experience in education reform and youth empowerment.
- Coordination of the Safer Living Pledge as a symbolic, unifying statement, with no financial contributions required from signatories.

All support is provided on a non-commercial, awareness-focused basis aligned with our core mission of enhancing access to education, efficiency in systems, and positive outcomes for youth facing challenges such as societal instability, health risks, and personal safety concerns.

### **The Meaning and Importance Behind the Pledge**

The Safer Living Pledge represents a simple yet powerful act of solidarity. In an era where young people navigate complex risks, from mental health pressures and substance-related harms to nightlife incidents like drink spiking, harassment, or violence, visible commitments from trusted institutions matter.

By signing, organizations publicly reaffirm values they already hold: prioritizing the safety, health, and well-being of youth. This collective visibility:

- Builds a culture of shared responsibility and awareness.
- Encourages participation in voluntary prevention efforts without mandating new actions or resources.
- Helps normalize conversations around safety in campuses, venues, and communities.
- Amplifies positive messaging that young people are valued, protected, and supported, contributing to optimism and resilience, core to NSN's global vision.

The Pledge is deliberately non-binding to ensure broad, inclusive participation while respecting the autonomy and existing obligations of all signatories. It is not a contract, funding mechanism, or regulatory tool, it is a statement of shared intent that strengthens community trust and highlights collective goodwill.

### **The Safer Living Pledge**

The cornerstone of NSN Safer Living is the Safer Living Pledge. A voluntary, symbolic reaffirmation of shared values. Signing does not create legal obligations, contracts, financial commitments, or liability beyond existing laws. It is a public statement of support for youth safety, health, and well-being.

Organizations invited to sign include:

- Universities and colleges
- Police forces and community safety partnerships
- Nightlife businesses (clubs, bars, venues)
- Government departments/branches (education, health, home office equivalents)
- Student unions and youth organizations
