The Youth Leadership Network is a collaboration between Leadership Fairfax and the County of Fairfax launched in January 2022. We believe all interested youth in the community must have access to high-quality facilitators and educators to increase their knowledge and build skills necessary for success. This new initiative provides a collective umbrella under which over 100 youth councils in the county can network with students and community leaders, engage in volunteer opportunities, and expand their leadership skills through educational courses that address leadership topics important to the next generation of leaders. The leadership network will also provide training opportunities for advisors and mentors working alongside the youth councils. There is no cost to join the Youth Leadership Network, and all educational training classes and benefits are at no cost to members.

Conversational Intelligence & Negotiation Skills – Dialogue and Difficult Conversations

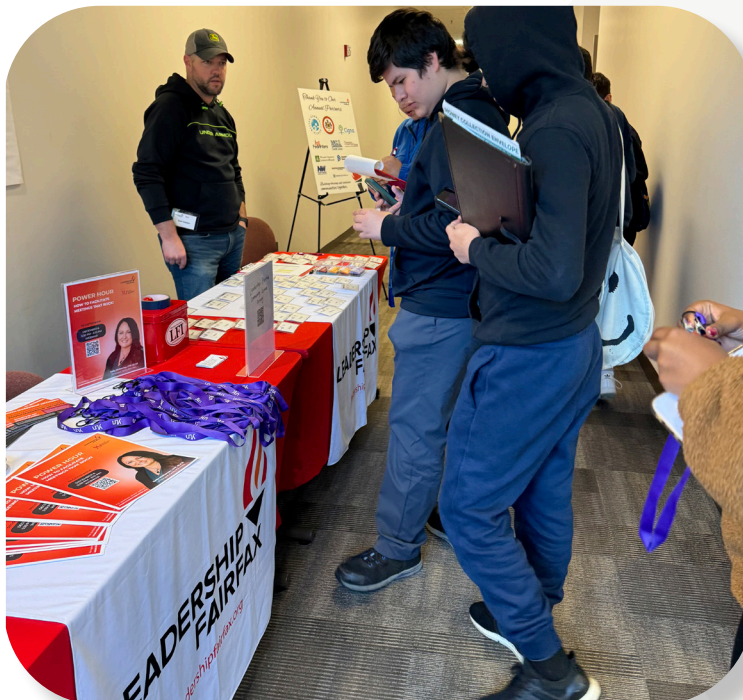
