- Inspired by the Reggio Emilia approach, our accredited Early Learning School, provides an authentic, art-based program for infants, toddlers, and preschool-aged children.
- Guided by our Atelerista, these weekly experiences encompass art exploration, art education, as well as projects using a variety of mediums, including observational drawing, painting, printmaking, watercolors, clay, and wire.
- Each spring the children's creative works are showcased in an annual community art show.

A HEALTHY START TO AN EDUCATIONAL JOURNEY

- We provide a nutritious morning and afternoon snack to the 136 children in our Early Learning School.
- Children attend a weekly culinary arts program taught by our Creative Foods Coordinator and explore different foods, food preparations, cooking skills, kitchen safety and nutrition.
- Physical fitness is designed with the whole child in mind, with the goal that all children develop competence and proficiency in a wide range of motor skills and an understanding of how their bodies move.

ENVIRONMENTAL SCIENCE: ANIMALS, THE ENVIRONMENT, & US

- Our Wildlife Studio features a wide array of live animals and artifacts to teach understanding, empathy, and respect for living things and their environment.
- Students are given the opportunity to care for the animals.
