

03 MAR (Tuesday):

SAINT KATHARINE DREXEL (1858-1955)

Born in 1858 into a prominent Philadelphia family, Katharine became imbued with love for God and neighbor. She took an avid interest in the material and spiritual well-being of black and native Americans. From the age of 33 until her death in 1955, she dedicated her life and a fortune of 20 million dollars to this work. In 1894, **Mother Drexel** took part in opening the first mission school for Indians, in Santa Fe, New Mexico. In 1915 she also founded Xavier University in New Orleans. At her death there were more than 500 Sisters teaching in 63 schools throughout the country.

NOVENA TO SAINT JOSEPH

Every **Wednesday** evening after the **05:30 PM** Mass there will be a novena to St. Joseph. This novena takes about 20 minutes. In addition to the novena, once a month the **05:30 PM** Mass will be in honor of St. Joseph. All are welcome to join in this celebration in honor of St. Joseph, husband of the Blessed Virgin Mary.



04 MAR (Wednesday):

SAINT CASIMIR OF POLAND (1458-1484)

Casimir was a 15th-century Polish prince, third in line for the throne. He lived a highly disciplined, often severe, life: sleeping on the ground, spending a great part of each night in prayer, and dedicating himself to lifelong celibacy (even under pressure to marry the daughter of the emperor). He had a great devotion to Mary, supported the poor, and lived a virtuous life amid the dissolute court.

07 MAR (Saturday):

SAINT PERPETUA and SAINT FELICITY, Martyrs (d. 203)

Perpetua was a noble woman of Carthage, and Felicity was her slave. While still catechumens they were arrested during the persecution of Christians under Emperor Septimus Severus and imprisoned in a private home where they were baptized. They were sentenced to death in a public amphitheater. When wild beasts failed to kill them, the women were killed by the sword.

ABSTINENCE: Everyone **fourteen years of age and older** is bound to abstain from meat on **ASH WEDNESDAY**, the **FRIDAYS** of Lent and **GOOD FRIDAY**.

FAST: Everyone **eighteen years of age and older, but under the age of sixty**, is also bound to fast on **ASH WEDNESDAY** and **GOOD FRIDAY**.

On these two days, the law of fast allows only one full meal a day, but does not prohibit taking some food during the day, so long as this does not constitute another full meal. Drinking liquids during the day is permitted. When health or ability to work would be seriously affected, the law does not oblige.


