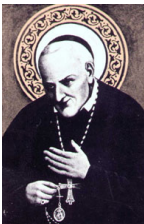

SAINTS AND OBSERVANCES

01 AUG (Tuesday):

SAINT ALPHONSUS MARIA DE LIGUORI, Bishop and Doctor of the Church (1696-1787)

Neapolitan lawyer (at the age of 16) who became a priest and founder of a new religious order, the *Redemptorists*, devoted to missionary work. He is noted for his opposition to Jansenism, and for his profuse writings, particularly his devotional works.



08 AUG (Tuesday):

SAINT DOMINIC, Founder of the Order of Preachers (1170-1221)

Spanish friar devoted to preaching against the Albigensian heresy. In 1206 he founded a community of nuns in Prouille, France, and later, with six followers, founded a community of preaching friars which gained papal approval in 1216 and became known as the Order of Preachers. Popularly known as the Dominicans, the order today has 6500 religious worldwide and is based on Dominic's concept of harmonizing the intellectual life with asceticism and apostolic works.

04 AUG (Friday):

SAINT JOHN MARY VIANNEY, Priest (1786-1859)

Ordained after many difficulties, John pastored a parish in the town of Ars, France, and became renowned for his counsel, often spending 11-16 hours in the confessional.

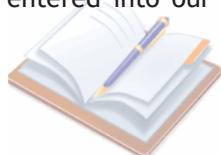


ROSARY OUTSIDE ABORTION CLINIC

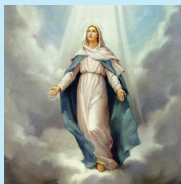

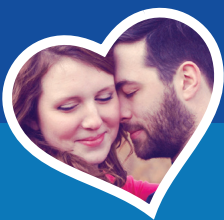
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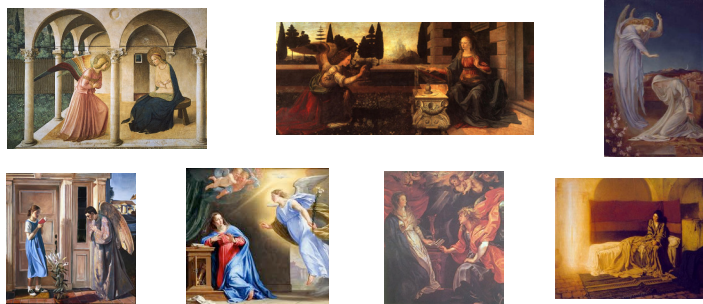

Miracles of God's Creation

Think about all the amazing things God has created. Take a few minutes to learn about some of the incredible things that have come from the imagination of our Creator!



Star-Gazing

Have you ever watched the stars on a clear, dark night? The longer you watch, the more stars you will see. Do you realize you are looking directly into the past -- in some cases into ancient history? Stars emit light, and light travels at a speed of

186,282 miles per second through the vacuum of space. Astronomers measure the distance between stars in units called "light-years" (the distance that light will travel in one year, which is about 5,880,500,000,000 miles).

The nearest star to Earth (besides the Sun) is Proxima Centauri (part of a 3-star cluster that includes the double-star Alpha Centauri). Proxima Centauri is 4.3 light-years from Earth, so the light from that star that reaches your eye tonight left Proxima Centauri just before the very first version of the Apple iPhone was announced. The light from other, farther stars might have left before the Revolutionary War, or during the Renaissance. Isn't our God amazing?
