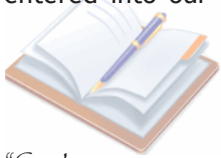

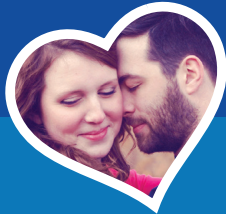

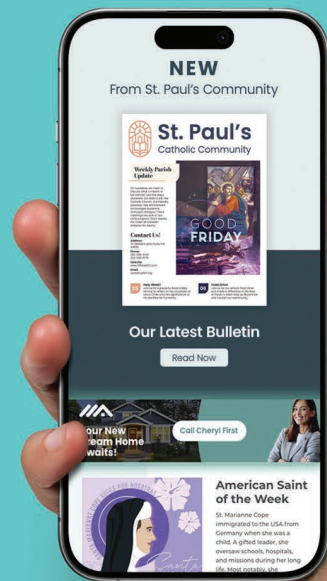

AN EASTERTIDE DEVOTION

Eastertide is the longest liturgical season of the church, stretching from Easter Sunday to Pentecost (50 days). It has [its own set of devotions](#), one of which is the *Via Lucis*, or *Stations of the Light*. These 14 “stations” celebrate the joyful events of the Easter season, including finding the empty tomb, breaking bread in Emmaus, the Ascension, and the descent of the Holy Spirit. There is no “how to pray these stations” guidance, but rather they are presented as a series of 14 opportunities for prayerful contemplation.

Miracles of God's Creation

Think about all the amazing things God has created. Take a few minutes to learn about some of the incredible things that have come from the imagination of our Creator!



Star-Gazing

Have you ever watched the stars on a clear, dark night? The longer you watch, the more stars you will see. Do you realize you are looking directly into the past -- in some cases into ancient history? Stars emit light, and light travels at a speed of **186,282** miles per second through the vacuum of space. Astronomers measure the distance between stars in units called “light-years” (the distance that light will travel in one year, which is about 5,880,500,000,000 miles). The nearest star to Earth (besides the Sun) is Proxima Centauri (part of a 3-star cluster that includes the double-star Alpha Centauri). Proxima Centauri is **4.3** light-years from Earth, so the light from that star that reaches your eye tonight left Proxima Centauri when Queen Elizabeth II was celebrating her Platinum Jubilee (70 years on the throne). The light from other, farther stars might have left before the Revolutionary War, or during the Renaissance. Isn't God amazing?
