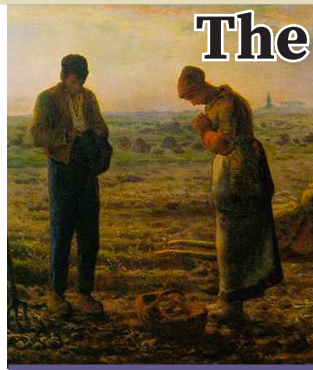

08 SEP (Tuesday): THE NATIVITY OF THE BLESSED VIRGIN MARY

12 SEP (Saturday): THE MOST HOLY NAME OF MARY

Feast of the entire Latin Church, celebrated on the Sunday within the octave of the Nativity of the Blessed Virgin. It was first observed at Cuenca, Spain in 1513, then extended to the universal Church and assigned to its present place and rank by **Pope Innocent XI** in **1683** in thanksgiving to God and the Blessed Virgin for the liberation of Vienna, France and the signal victory over the Turks on **12 September 1683**. It is the titular feast of the *Society of Mary (Marianists)* and of the *Congregation of the Oblates of Mary Immaculate*.



09 SEP (Wednesday): SAINT PETER CLAVER, Priest (1581-1654)

A Jesuit missionary to America, Peter ministered physically and spiritually to the slaves when they arrived in Cartagena. He reportedly converted 300,000, and worked for humane treatment on the plantations for 40 years. He organized charitable societies among the Spanish in America similar to those in Europe by **St. Vincent de Paul**.

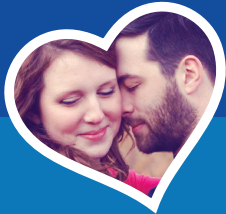

ST. VINCENT DE PAUL SOCIETY REPORT

Dear parishioners,

We are pleased to provide you with information about the activities of the Nativity St Vincent de Paul Society in the first half of 2026.

For the 6 months ended June 30, we received \$59,700 in donations from Brown Bag Sundays and other donations. We had total expenses of \$65,100. Most of our expenses were for grocery store gift cards, and we also had a small amount for rent assistance, as well as gifts to other agencies supported by St Vincent de Paul. Our administrative costs, primarily bank and money transfer fees, were just under \$400. We made 700 "house calls", delivering food and gift cards to over 500 people per month. We estimate that children represent more than half of the recipients of our assistance.

As we enter the second half of the year, we continue to be very busy. Rent requests, which of course are sizable in our area, and assistance with beds, are rising. In addition, we incurred costly repairs to our very actively-used freezer. Generous donations at the end of 2025 and in early 2026 provided us with reserves to cover the loss incurred in the first half of 2026. However, as of early August our bank balance was very low.
