#### 07 DEC (Sunday):

#### SAINT AMBROSE, Bishop and Doctor of the Church

Ambrose was a Roman citizen who served in the imperial government. Elected Bishop of Milan by popular acclaim, he was revered for his service to the poor and his writings against the Arian heresy.

#### 08 DEC (Monday):

#### IMMACULATE CONCEPTION OF THE VIRGIN MARY

This dogma, declared in **1854**, teaches that Mary was redeemed from the first moment of her conception.

By the merits of her Son, Jesus Christ, she is preserved immune from all stain of original sin by a singular grace and privilege of almighty God. (Pius IX).



#### 09 DEC (Tuesday) SAINT JUAN DIEGO (1474-1548)

Born an impoverished freeman in a strongly classconscious society, Cuauhtlatoatzin became an adult convert to Christianity at the age of 50, taking the name Juan Diego. The Virgin Mary appeared to him on 09 December 1531, leaving him her image

on his tilma. He was canonized by Pope John Paul II in July of 2002.

## 12 DEC (Friday) OUR LADY OF GUADALUPE (1531)

The Blessed Virgin appeared to Juan Diego in 1531 calling herself the Mother of the True God and promising compassion and protection to all who come to her. She left an image of herself on his cloak, which is still preserved at the shrine of Our Lady of Guadalupe in Mexico City. Under



this title, Mary has been declared *Patroness of the Americas*.

#### 13 DEC (Saturday) SAINT LUCY, Martyr (~283 - ~304)

**St. Lucy** was a young Christian of Greek ancestry, living in Syracuse in the early fourth century. Like many early Christian women, she devoted herself completely to Jesus. But her mother betrothed her to a pagan, and Lucy was only able to change her mother's mind after praying at the tomb of **St.** 



**Agatha** to cure her mother's illness. However, the spurned pagan suitor denounced her as a Christian, and she was martyred.

#### THE "SAINT ANDREW" NOVENA

This is a longer devotion of the *Christmas Novena*, and has been observed in this form for centuries. In this form, the novena prayer is recited **fifteen times each day** for the entire duration of Advent. It is often referred to as "The St. Andrew Novena" as the recitation begins on St. Andrew's feast day (30 NOV).

Most Catholics are familiar with this prayer ("...at midnight...in piercing cold...") and this longer devotion brings with it many blessings.

#### SIMBANG GABI FOR DEANERY 11

What is Simbang Gabi (meaning "Masses at Night")? It is a long-treasured Filipino spiritual tradition. In the Philippines, it is celebrated as a series of nine dawn Masses right before Christmas, each Mass followed by a reception and fellowship. Beginning on 15 DEC and ending on 23 DEC, these daily novena Masses are now also celebrated in the evening. Set within Advent, Simbang Gabi invites participants to heighten their preparation



for the birth of Jesus, as well as honor the Blessed Virgin Mary. The most popular symbol for *Simbang Gabi* is the *parol*, or star lantern, with represents the star of Bethlehem. A parol is usually brought up during the processional to remind us of the guiding light that led many to the manger. The following Churches in Deanery 11 will be having Masses for *Simbang Gabi*:

## TRADITIONS AROUND THE WORLD

#### DÍA de las VELITAS (Day of the Little Candles)

Holy Sacrifice of the Mass

**Día de las Velitas** is one of the most-observed traditional holidays of **Colombia**. It is celebrated on **o7 December**, on the eve of the *Immaculate Conception*, which is a public holiday in Colombia. This day is the unofficial start of the Christmas season in the country.

05:30 PM

On this day, people place candles and paper lanterns on their windows, balconies, porches, sidewalks, streets, parks and squares, in short, everywhere they can be seen, in honor of the Virgin Mary and her Immaculate Conception.

The celebration of the Day of the Candles dates to **1854**. On **08 DEC 1854**, **Pope Pius IX** solemnly defined as dogma the Immac-



ulate Conception of the Virgin Mary, published in his constitution *Ineffabilis Deus*. In Colombia, as in many places all over the world, this announcement was observed by lighting candles. The Catholic Church of Colombia kept alive the celebration and made

an annual tradition of lighting candles the night of o7 December. El Día de las Velitas is celebrated throughout Colombia, but traditions vary in each region and city.
