08 AUG (Tuesday):

SAINT DOMINIC, Founder of the Order of Preachers(1170-1221)

Spanish friar devoted to preaching against the Albigensian heresy. In 1206 he founded a community of nuns in Prouille, France, and later, with six followers, founded a community of preaching friars which gained papal approval in 1216 and became known as the Order of Preachers. Popularly known as the Dominicans, the order today has 6500 religious worldwide and is based on Dominic's concept of harmonizing the intellectual life with asceticism and apostolic works.

11 AUG (Friday):

SAINT CLARE of ASSISI (1194-1253)



An Italian noblewoman who followed her great friend, Francis of Assisi into a life of poverty. Several other women gathered round her at the monastery of San Damiano, which still stands today. Her monastic community endured, and came to be known as the Poor Clares. She daily meditated on the Passion. Towards the end of her life, when she was too ill to attend Mass, an image of the service would appear on the wall of her cell; thus her patronage of television.

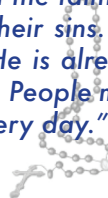

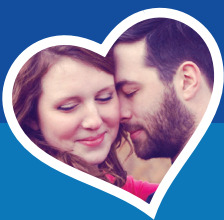
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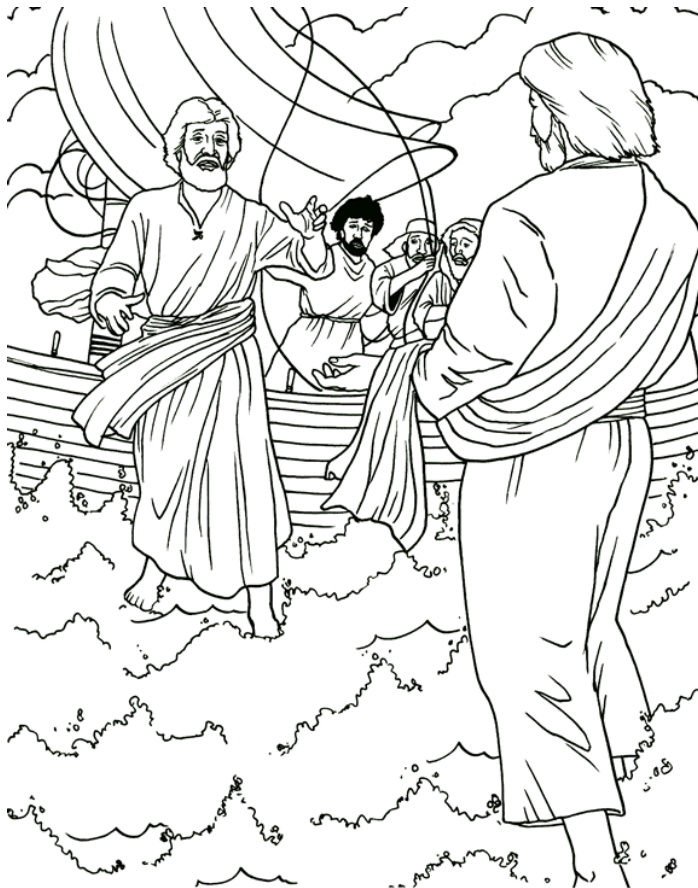

AUGUST, MONTH OF THE IMMACULATE HEART

Did you know that the month of August is dedicated to the Immaculate Heart of Mary? Since the 16th century, Catholic piety has assigned entire months to special devotions. The month of August is traditionally dedicated to the Immaculate Heart. The physical heart of Mary is venerated (and not adored as the Sacred Heart of Jesus is) because it is united to her person and is the seat of her love (especially for her divine Son), virtue, and inner life. Such devotion is an incentive to a similar love and virtue.

This devotion has received new emphasis in this century from the visions given to Lucy Dos Santos, oldest of the visionaries of Fatima, in her convent in Tuy, in Spain, in 1925 and 1926. In the visions Our Lady asked for the practice of the Five First Saturdays to help make amends for the offenses committed against her heart by the blasphemies and ingratitude of men. The practice parallels the devotion of the Nine First Fridays in honor of the Sacred Heart.

On October 31, 1942, Pope Pius XII made a solemn Act of Consecration of the Church and the whole world to the Immaculate Heart. Let us remember this devotion year-round, but particularly through the month of August.
