SAINT NICHOLAS TAVELIC AND COMPANIONS, Martyrs

As Franciscan custodians of the shrines in the Holy Land, Nicholas,

Deodat, Peter of Narbonne and Stephen of Cuneo decided to take a direct approach to converting the Muslims. On November 11,

1391, they went to the huge Mosque of Omar in Jerusalem and

asked to see the Qadi (Muslim official). Reading from a prepared

statement, they said that all people must accept the gospel of

Jesus. When they were ordered to retract their statement, they

refused. After beatings and imprisonment, they were beheaded

SAINT MARTIN OF TOURS, Bishop (c. 316-397)

Martin was born to pagan parents; his father was a Roman military officer and tribune. Martin joined the Roman imperial army at age 15. He once gave a beggar half of his heavy officer's cloak, and later had a vision of Jesus wearing the cloak. Martin was persecuted by the Arians, who were openly hostile to Catholics, and later became first a hermit, then the bishop of Tours. Martin was the first non-martyr to receive the cultus of a saint.

12 NOV (Wednesday) SAINT JOSAPHAT, Bishop and Martyr (1580-1623)

Nicholas and his companions were canonized in 1970. They are the only Franciscans martyred in the Holy Land to be canonized.
