



THE NEXT DOCTOR OF THE CHURCH

Pope Leo XIV has announced that he will declare **St. John Henry Newman** the **38th Doctor of the Church**. The pope's namesake, Pope Leo XIII, made Newman a Cardinal in 1879.

The Bishops' Conference of England and Wales had formally

petitioned Pope Francis to confer the title in May 2024. The initiative was strongly supported by other bishops' conferences, including those of the United States, Ireland, and Scotland, as well as many academic institutions and religious communities worldwide. Read more here:
