SAINT CORNELIUS, Pope and Martyr, and **SAINT CYPRIAN, Bishop and Martyr**

Cornelius was the 21st pope, elected during a time when persecutions were so bad that papal ascension was a quick death sentence. He worked to maintain unity in a time of schism and apostasy. He called a synod of bishops to confirm him as rightful pontiff. Among

his supporters was St. Cyprian.

SAINTS ANDREW KIM TAEGON, Priest and Martyr, PAUL CHONG HASANG, Martyr, and Their Companions, Martyrs

During an outbreak of persecution that occured in Korea in 1839, 1846, and 1867, some 103 members of the Korean Christian community gave their lives as martyrs.

THE SACRED STIGMATA OF SAINT FRAN-**CIS OF ASSISI**



SAINT ROBERT BELLARMINE, Bishop (1542-1621)

Jesuit who taught and wrote extensively; he authored the most complete work of his time defending Catholicism against the Protestant attack. He also wrote catechisms for children and teachers, and was part of the commission for the 1592 revision of the Vulgate Bible. He was a spiritual advisor to Saint Aloysius Gonzaga, helped Saint Frances de Sales in the founding of the Visitation Order, and defended Galileo Galilei, with whom he corresponded regularly. He was also the head of the Vatican Library.



YOU KNOW

A video of former NFL quarterback **Tim Tebow** recalling an amazing Biblical 'coincidence' in his life went viral on social media in JAN 2018.

The story begins with Tebow in his college football years. It was **2009** and he was weeks away from competing in the highly televised national championship football game.

Tebow said God led him to write *John 3:16* under his eyes for all the world to see while he played.

After winning the championship game he found out something incredible happened: during the game, 94 million people Googled *John* 3:16

"Honestly my first thought was 'How do 94 million people not know John 3:16?" Tebow said. "I was just so humbled by how big the God is that we serve."

Fast-forward three years to **2012**. Tebow is a Denver Bronco playing the Pittsburgh Steelers in the playoffs, and after the Broncos won, he headed into the post-game press conference when his public relations representative stopped him in his tracks.

"He says, 'Timmy, did you realize what happened? It's exactly three years later from the day that you wore **John 3:16** under your eyes,'" Tebow continued. "I was like, 'Oh, that's really cool."

"He said, 'No, I don't think you realize what happened. During the game you threw for 316 yards, your yards per completion were 31.6, your yards per rush were 3.16, the ratings for the night we're 31.6, and the time of possession was 31.06 and during the game 91 million people googled John 3:16 and it's the number one trending thing on every platform."
