

THE SEVEN FOUNDERS OF THE ORDER OF SERVITES (1233)

On the **Feast of the Assumption** in 1240, the **Founders** received a vision of Our Lady. She held in her hand a black habit, and a nearby angel bore a scroll reading *Servants of Mary*. Mary told them, “*You will found a new order, and you will be my witnesses throughout the world. This is your name: Servants of Mary. This is your rule: that of Saint Augustine. And here is your distinctive sign: the black scapular, in memory of my sufferings.*” By 1285 there were 10,000 members with houses in Germany, France, Italy, and Spain.



ABSTINENCE: Everyone **fourteen years of age and older** is bound to abstain from meat on **ASH WEDNESDAY**, the **FRIDAYS of Lent** and **GOOD FRIDAY**.

FAST: Everyone **eighteen years of age and older**, but **under the age of sixty**, is also bound to fast on **ASH WEDNESDAY** and **GOOD FRIDAY**.

On these two days, the law of fast allows only one full meal a day, but does not prohibit taking some food during the day, so long as this does not constitute another full meal. Drinking liquids during the day is permitted. When health or ability to work would be seriously affected, the law does not oblige.

ST. ANTHONY'S PADUA DINING HALL

On the weekend of **14-15 FEB 2026**, there will be a special second collection in support of St. Anthony's Padua Dining Hall. The Dining Hall, which has been in operation for over 50 years, serves up to 600 individuals, six days a week, providing them with a hot meal as well as grocery bags and clothing assistance to local families. Last year, over 100,000 hot meals were served to our neighbors in need with no questions asked and no one ever turned away.


