20 AUG (Wednesday):

SAINT BERNARD, Abbot and Doctor of the Church (1894-1941)

Fearing the ways of the world, Bernard of Clairvaux, along with

four of his brothers and 25 friends, joined the abbey of Citeaux. Their father and another brother joined shortly after. He founded and led the monastery of Clairvaux, which soon had 700 monks and 160 daughter houses. He is the first Cistercian monk to be placed on the calendar of saints.



23 AUG (Saturday): SAINT ROSE OF LIMA (1586-1618)

The first saint born in the Americas, to parents who were immigrants to Peru. A beautiful girl and devoted daughter, she was so devoted to her vow of chastity that she used pepper and lye to ruin her



complexion so she would not be attractive. A mystic and visionary, she received the stigmata invisibly. She had a particularly great devotion to **Saint Catherine of Siena**.


