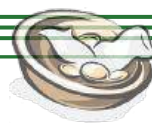

SAINTS AND OBSERVANCES

SOLEMNITY, FEAST, MEMORIAL • OPTIONAL MEMORIAL • OTHER

20 JAN (Tuesday):

SAINT FABIAN, Pope (d. ~250)

A layman farmer who happened to be in Rome on the day a new pope was to be chosen. A dove flew over the crowd and alighted on Fabian's head, and the assembled clergy and laity took this as a sign from God, and made Fabian the 20th pope. He was martyred in the persecutions of Decius.

SAINT SEBASTIAN, Martyr (d. ~288)

The son of a wealthy Roman family, Sebastian was an officer in Diocletian's army, and captain of the guard. When he was charged as a Christian, Diocletian ordered him tied to a tree and shot with arrows. He survived and recovered with the help of Saint Irene, and returned to preach directly to Diocletian, who then had him martyred by being beaten to death.



21 JAN (Wednesday):

SAINT AGNES, Martyr (d. ~254)

At age 12 or 13 Agnes was ordered to sacrifice to pagan gods and lose her virginity by rape. She was threatened, then tortured and martyred when she refused to turn against God. On her feast day two lambs are blessed at her church in Rome, Italy and then their wool is woven into the palliums (bands of white wool) which the Pope confers on archbishops.

24 JAN (Saturday):

SAINT FRANCIS DE SALES, Bishop and Doctor of the Church (1567-1622)

Bishop of Geneva who sought to bring many back to the Church through his personal life and writings, especially his *Controversies* and several devout treatises, including his *Introduction to the Devout Life*, written especially for ordinary lay people living active lives in the world. With St. Jane Frances de Chantal he co-founded the Visitation Order.

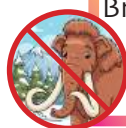

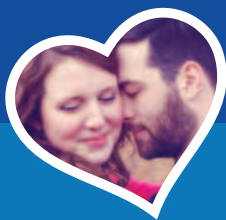

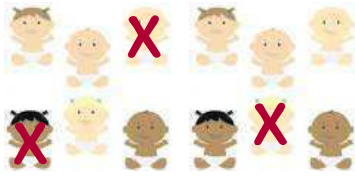

"16 WEEKS' GESTATION"

Many statistics use a time-point of **16 weeks' gestation**. Why? In order to address questions like "when does life begin?", it is pretty hard to argue that a baby after 16 weeks' gestation is a "clump of tissue". Consider what medical science knows about this point in the baby's development:

- The body is fully formed; the fingers and toes have fingerprints and nails.
- The baby is about 5 inches long and weighs about 3 ounces (about the size of a large avocado).
- The baby is moving about: he/she may grasp for the umbilical cord, suck their thumb, be able to make facial expressions and kick at the amniotic sac.
- The heart and circulatory system and the urinary tract are fully functioning, and the blood is pumping through the tiny veins
- The baby is inhaling and exhaling the amniotic fluid through the lungs.
- The eyes are in the proper position, and the baby can see straight ahead and blink his/her eyelids.
- The genitals have formed. In the case of a girl, the uterus has already developed and the ovaries are in the proper place.
- In the case of twins, after **14 weeks'** gestation they will execute movements specifically aimed at the other twin.

"MEET THE KILLERS"

GUNS	Kill approximately 30,000 people each year in the U.S. 55% of those deaths are self-inflicted.
ALCOHOL	Kills approximately 35,000 people each year in the U.S. 71% of those deaths are self-inflicted.
CIGARETTES	Kill approximately 440,000 people each year in the U.S. 91% of those deaths are self inflicted.
