## **ICS TRAINING OPPORTUNITY – DECEMBER 2025**

Marble Falls Fire Rescue, 700 Avenue N, Marble Falls TX 78654, will be hosting G-300: Intermediate ICS for Expanding Incidents & G-400: Advanced ICS for Complex Incidents classes on **December 8-12, 2025**.

The courses are highly recommended by the Texas Division of Emergency Management (TDEM) for emergency responders or individuals with roles in their organizations Emergency Operations Center (EOC). These courses equip individuals with the skills and knowledge to effectively manage incidents of varying complexity, from single-agency responses to large-scale, multi-agency events. They are also prerequisite courses for position specific training such as Operations Section Chief, Incident Commander, Planning Section Chief, etc.

By providing a standardized framework, ICS promotes effective communication and coordination among different agencies and personnel during emergencies. It is the national standard for emergency response operations.

The following online classes are pre-requisites before you may register for G-300 and G-400:

IS-100.C	Introduction to the Incident Command System
IS-200.C	Basic Incident Command System for Initial Response
IS-700.B	An Introduction to the National Incident Management System
IS-800.D	National Response Framework, An Introduction

Once your account is active, you will need to download your IS-100.C, IS-200.C, IS-700.B and IS-800.D certificates under the "Request Credit" tab on the left side of the page so that you will have the prerequisites needed to register for the G-300: Intermediate ICS for Expanding Incidents & G-400: Advanced ICS for Complex Incidents classes.
