The Session of First Presbyterian Church has approved a project to redesign the Memory Garden outside of Westminster Hall. The concept is to build a beautiful space using bricks to create a dignified and attractive courtyard area. Such courtyards can be seen at colleges and universities, hospitals and medical centers, and other public spaces where institutional memory is valued. The Brick Opportunity has a threefold aim. The obvious goal is the beautification of the area outside Westminster Hall, making it a more attractive space on the downtown riverfront. The second outcome is the opportunity for grateful remembrance. The bricks that will grace the courtyard are memorial pieces purchased and dedicated to loved ones, friends, or memories related to FPC or to Palatka. The third outcome is what will be called the Legacy Fund, an endowment dedicated to the maintenance and improvement of our historic church building that will be funded through the brick purchases. The endowment fund will ensure that resources will always be available to keep our buildings up to date and in good repair. Elliott Kane is leading the Session in promotion of the project. Suzie Cornelio has produced promotional material and has coordinated with the brick manufacturer and a local contractor that will install them. Both Elliott and Suzie will be available to answer your questions and assist
