- In 500 words or less, please explain your current career and educational goals, particularly as they pertain to hospitality management, and the reasons you are requesting this scholarship. Why should you be granted this scholarship and how do you intend to use the funds?
- Submit a signed letter of recommendation from your current/most recent Club Manager.
- Submit your current transcripts, and any other appropriate materials supporting your request for the scholarship.
- Fill out the form below and include it as your application cover page.

Recipients of this scholarship will be notified of their award in November 2024. Any funds distributed will be sent in check form with the payee line including both the recipient student's name and the college's or university's name. A letter will be included asking the institution to apply the funds to the student's account for payment of tuition, room and board, meal plans, books, study abroad and fees necessary for full participation in educational programs (i.e. technology fees, activities fees, etc.).
