A Beatrice native and graduate of BHS, **DICK TERHUNE** was one of the founding members of Community Players along with his parents, Terry (first president, master carpenter and actor) and Shirley (longtime house manager). He performed here in productions of *The Boyfriend*, *Cat on a Hot Tin Roof*, *The Apple Tree*, *Once Upon a Mattress* and *Cinderella*. He also performed for a decade at the Lincoln Community Playhouse (where he was inducted as a Playhouse "Legend" in 2018) and at Pinewood Bowl. He has performed this one-man version of *A Christmas Carol* since 2019 at theatres around the country. He currently resides in Connecticut where he regularly works on stage, film and TV. Recent stage credits include *The Mousetrap* and *Rock of Ages* (both directed by Hunter Foster), as Editor Webb in *Our Town* (alongside Jane Kaczmarek), and as Karl Lindner in *A Raisin In The Sun*. He recently co-starred on an episode of *FBI: Most Wanted* with Dylan McDermott on CBS and Paramount+. You may recognize his voice from commercials for Great Wolf Lodge, Little Caesar's, Yoplait (and others), games including *World of Warcraft*, *Diablo Immortal*, *Vampire: The Masquerade* and the animated series *Transformers: Cyberverse* as Macadam and Prowl. This performance is lovingly dedicated to the countless volunteers who brought this organization to life and have kept it alive and thriving for fifty fabulous seasons!

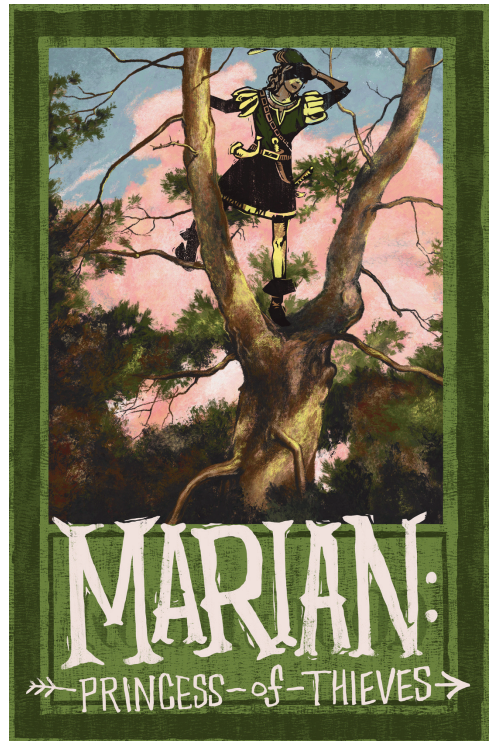

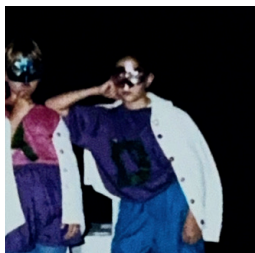
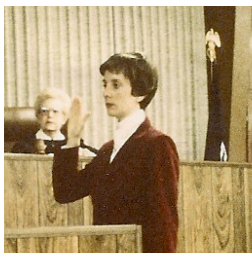
