After I have my ticket, I go through the open door to the auditorium.



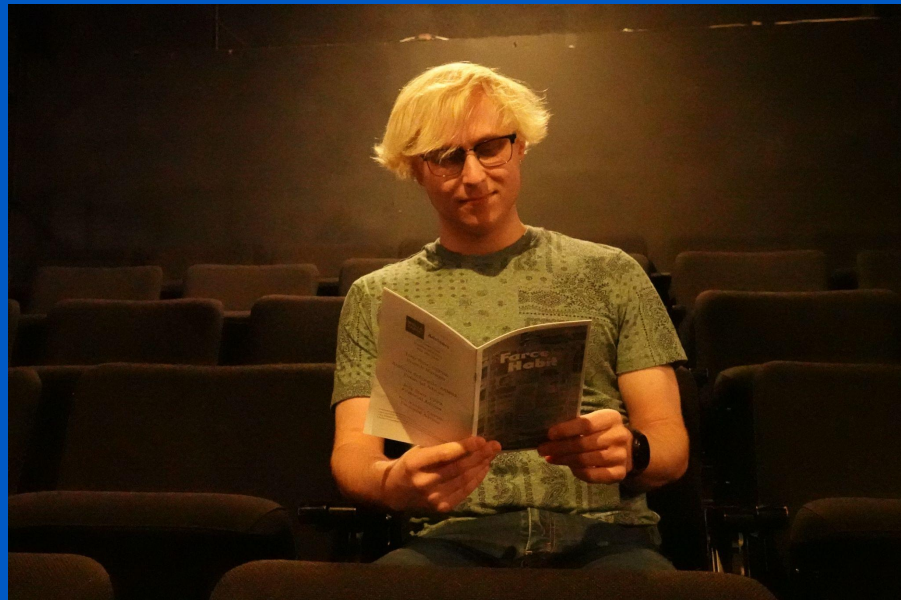
An usher scans my
