Even if cremated remains are present, the service is classified as a memorial since the disposition (cremation) has already occurred. You're welcome to choose any service title you prefer, such as "celebration of life." We use these terms primarily to help clarify the type of service being planned.

You'll also encounter the term "final disposition," which refers to the ultimate handling of a deceased person's remains. It encompasses the method by which the body is permanently cared for after death. While burial is considered final disposition, cremation itself is not, as it leaves behind remains that still require further placement. For cremation, final disposition can involve ground burial, placement in a columbarium, scattering of the ashes, and many other options.
