A Short History of the Horticultural Show by David Edwards

A Doddington cottage Horticultural Society was first formed in August 1892 at the suggestion of Mr TR Harding of Coney House with the first show held at the end of September that year. The show was held in The Old Rectory grounds, now Doddington Hall. There were 42 classes for flowers, fruits and vegetables, the winner of each class receiving 2s (10p), 2nd 1s 6d(7 1/2p) and 3rd 1s (5p). There was also a special prize of 10s (50p) awarded to the owner of the best donkey, which was won by my great grandfather William Beard.

This series of shows was held annually until 1913 and from 1901 to 1913 was combined with a sports day. The 1914 show was cancelled due to declining support for the show rather than the first world war.

In 1935 and 1936 the show was revived by the Methodist Chapel, the 1936 show included baking classes but it was not until 1943 that the Doddington Horticultural Society was re-formed and an annual show has been held ever since, except in 1946 and the two Covid years 2020 and 2021.

In April 1943 Ald AD Burton was elected president of the new society with Dr C Thomas as Chairman, Mr RA Pegg secretary and Mr H Wool treasurer. the first show was held on July 22nd in the British Legion Hall with side shows , games fancy dress and a baby show held in the adjoining field. The day concluded with a dance in the hall.

The show continued on the same lines for the next two years, but in 1946

Mr RA Pegg, the secretary and also the village policeman, was transferred to another village at an inopportune time and the show was cancelled for that year.

Revived again in 1947, the show thrived for the next 20 years under the Chairmanship of Tom Edgeley and secretary Harold Palmer with the number of classes increasing from 68 to 132.

The first cups were awarded in 1947 The Challenge Cup for most overall points was won by C Moon and the runners up cup by F Bester. The first trophy for children was awarded in 1948 to Janet Miller. There have been many different cups over the years. Perhaps one of the most interestingly named is the Home Guard Cup, first awarded in 1958 and not commemorating the wartime Home Guard , but the short lived revival during the Cold War 1952 - 56, who donated their remaining funds on their disbandment to purchase the trophy.

From 1956-1978 the Miss Doddington competition formed part of the evening event, that trophy being used for the adult art section since 1980. For several years in the 1950s the show was held on the same day as the children's sports.

Some other long serving officials of the society include Frank Payne (Secretary 1968-80) Bill Ellington (Chairman 1972-86, President 1987-2000) Horace Shaw (Chairman 1989-2004)

Jane Archer (Secretary 1994-2006) Albert Short (President 2001-2015) and Mrs Lyne Green (Secretary 2007-2017)

The 75th show was held in 2022 and was the first at the Benwick Road Recreation Field which heralded the return of stalls and sideshows not included since the 1950s.

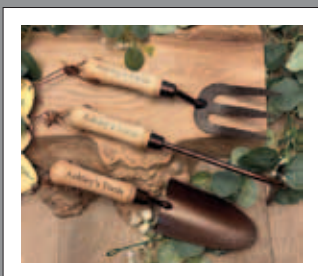
