

Foodness for The Soul

Cook's Recipe:

MUSHroom Ravioli Bake:

- 2 Tbsp butter
- 1 Tbsp minced garlic
- 1 cup half-n-half
- 1 jar (any) alfredo sauce
- 1 8oz pkg sliced baby bella mushrooms
- 1 pkg mushroom ravioli
- shredded parmesan/romano cheese

In a pan, sauté butter, garlic (salt/pepper to taste), mushrooms & cream, put lid & simmer (slowly) until mushrooms are soft. Boil ravioli in pot for 3-4 mins. Add alfredo to mushroom sauce. In a baking dish, pour half sauce, add ravioli & then add rest of sauce on top. Bake at 350 for 10 minutes or until bubbling. Add cheese on top and bake another 2-3 minutes until cheese is melted. Serve hot!

*you may make as much sauce as you like... just increase ingredients equally! (no need for more alfredo)

Baker's Recipe:

Lace cookies

- 1 cup (2 sticks) Salted butter\
- 1 3/4 cup dark brown sugar
- 1/4 cup granulated sugar
- 2 Tbsp honey
- 1 tsp vanilla extract
- 1/4 tsp ground cinnamon
- 1/4 tsp salt
- 1 lrg egg
- 2 cups quick oats
- 3 Tbsp all-purpose flour
- 6 oz bittersweet chocolate (chopped)

Preheat oven to 350F and line 2 baking sheets with parchment paper or silicone baking mats. In a medium saucepan, combine butter, brown sugar, granulated sugar & honey over med. heat & cook, whisking until bubbling and the sugar is dissolved (5 mins). Pour mixture into large, heatproof bowl & whisk in vanilla, cinnamon & salt. Let cool until warm (not hot), about 20 mins. Add egg, whisking until smooth. Stir in the oats and flour. Scoop 1 This p mounds to baking sheet, 3 inches apart. Bake, rotating pans halfway through, until edges golden brown. Remove & cool for 5 mins before transferring to cooling rack. Cool completely. *Allow baking sheets to cool completely between each use* Place chocolate in microwave safe bowl & microwave until melted (stir every 15 secs) Either drizzle on top or make a "sandwich" cookie/chocolate/cookie

Let set for at least 1 hour before serving!



Advent Greetings!

I pray this letter finds you all well in this blessed Advent and winter season. Advent is a joyous time in which we are called to remember the promises of the Lord, especially that Christ will come again.

Advent, which is derived from the Latin word *adventus* meaning "coming" is meant to help us focus on what it must have been like to first receive the promised Messiah AND remember that the Lord is coming again.
