



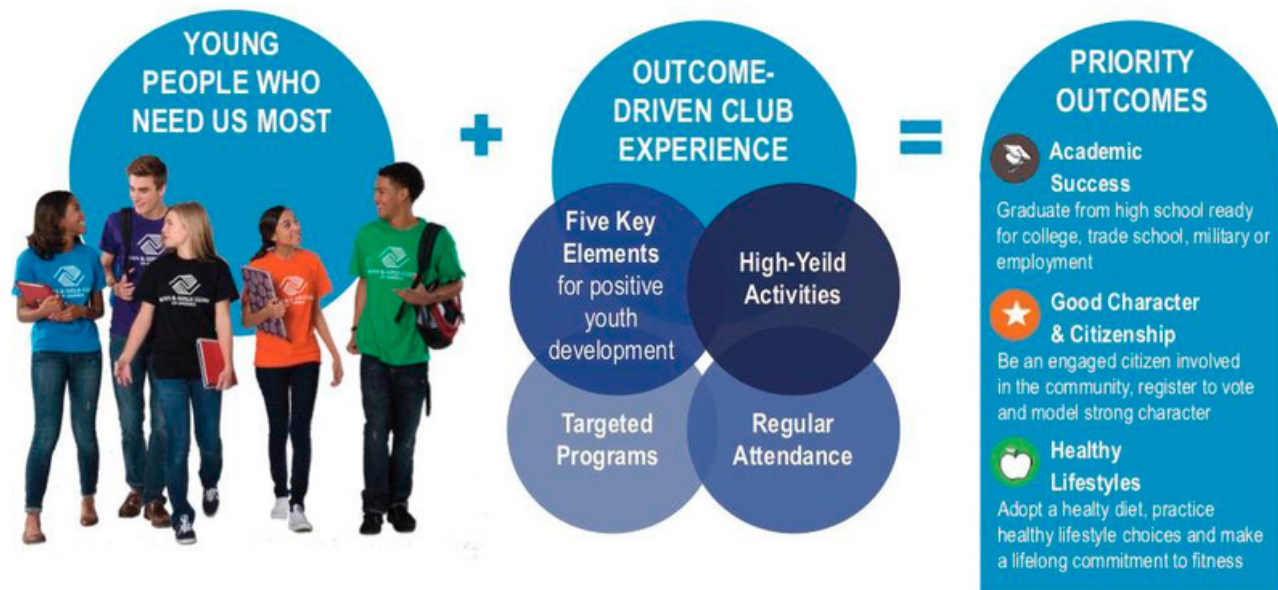

Dear Club Friends,

Later this month, we will mark three decades of service to the children in our community. Your support this past year has brought about a profound transformation in the lives of nearly 400 Corridor children. Thanks to your generosity, we have been able to offer 31 programs throughout the year, all of which contribute to the academic success, healthy lifestyles, and development of good character and citizenship among children and teens in our community.

With four dedicated units scattered throughout Cedar Rapids, one in Iowa City, and another in Marion, our impactful programs for school-age children and teens are reaching those who need our services the most, making a tangible difference in the lives of hundreds of youth and their families.

In the past year, the impact of your investment became evident as 9% of Club members improved their reading skills, while 8% showed enhanced math proficiency. We also extended our reach by providing 525 Thanksgiving Dinners to Club families and coordinated the adoption of 200 children in 60 families through our Adopt-A-Family program last December. Additionally, thanks to investments from the community, dirt has begun to move at the site of our new Busse Unit and we are on our way to opening in early 2025!

As we prepare to celebrate our 30th Anniversary, we invite you to join us November 16th at the Flamingo, as we return to our roots on Ellis Boulevard Northwest. Our openhouse style event will include time for socializing and reminiscing, heavy hor d'oeuvres, and a short presentation. Please RSVP by calling our office or emailing ssproston@inmyclub.org.

Progress On Busse Unit

Last year, we announced our Unlocking the Future Capital Campaign to build a new Club on the Southeast side of Cedar Rapids. Well, we've got some good news to share! We're making progress at the site of our new Busse Unit, thanks to the efforts of the folks at Hunter Companies and OPN Architects. They've been working tirelessly to kick-start our project.

Of course, it hasn't come without challenges. COVID, supply chain snags, and a shortage of skilled workers threw some curve balls our way, causing delays and pushing our timeline back a ways. The good news is, in just a few weeks, we'll have the footings and foundation wrapped up. Come spring, brick laying will begin and the major construction phase will officially kick off! We're now estimating that we'll be ready to open the doors to the Busse Unit and begin serving kids in early 2025.

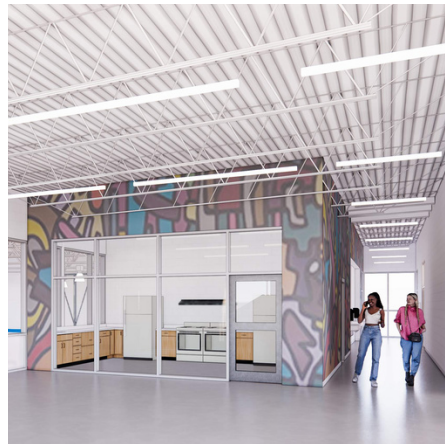

Iowa City Celebrates 5 Years!

This past May, we celebrated our fifth anniversary since chartering our Iowa City site with Boys & Girls Clubs of America. This milestone coincided with opening a newly renovated space inside Parkview Church, providing us a larger area for daily Club activities and enabling us to expand our programs, thereby doubling our Iowa City membership. To mark these achievements, we hosted a ribbon-cutting ceremony in collaboration with the Iowa City Area Business Partnership.

Over the past half-decade, our partnership with Parkview Church and Faith Academy School has been instrumental in supporting our mission to inspire and enable the children who need us most in Iowa City. Faith Academy provides a private school education for elementary age students of families in Iowa City who might otherwise be unable to afford it. We are proud to work alongside Faith Academy to help students from economically disadvantaged backgrounds in overcoming the achievement gap that often affects our classrooms. Our collaboration has made a profound and lasting impact on the lives of the children and their families, embodying the essence of community support and educational empowerment.

Through the Club's educational programs, Power Hour and STEM, Club members receive additional educational support that coincides with what they are learning during the school day.

Youth of the Year

Youth of the Year is the highest honor a Club member can receive within Boys & Girls Clubs of America. Each year teens from across the nation compete at the local, regional and national levels where one teen is named National Youth of the Year. This year our representative from the Corridor was Olivet Club member, Donya Stanley.

Ten-year Club member, Donya, calls Boys & Girls Club her second home. When she first joined the Club in kindergarten, Donya struggled to properly communicate her feelings to others, modeling what she saw outside of Club. As a Club member, Donya received the guidance she needed to help her better understand herself. From learning life skills and building new friendships, to participating in fun activities and service projects as a Club member and now Junior Staff member, all of these experiences shaped Donya into the responsible, caring young person she is today.

Elementary and early middle school were tough times for Donya as she didn't understand why people made fun of others for being themselves. She found that by trying to fit in, she was hiding her true self. While all Club programming influenced Donya, she specifically attributes the SMART Girls (Skills Mastery and Resilience Training) program, to instilling in her a better understanding of how to relate to others while remaining true to herself. The safe, judgment-free space of SMART Girls allowed her to be herself without the fear of judgment from others, giving her a huge boost of confidence.

Club staff, particularly Olivet Unit Director Taryn Kurth, played a pivotal role in Donya's life. Taryn, who is a mother figure to Donya and all of the Olivet Club kids, takes a personal interest in their well-being. Donya emphasizes that Taryn goes above and beyond by taking them to movies, trying new foods, and ensuring they have food and clothing when needed. For instance, Taryn would take Donya to get snacks or drinks before the younger kids arrived at Club. She encouraged Donya to order for herself at coffee shops, telling Donya, "No order, no drink," This forced her to step up and do things for herself. Donya took this simple lesson and applied it to more than just ordering coffee. "I used to get into fights when other kids gave me a hard time, but Club staff taught me to stand up for myself and walk away from bad situations." Taryn's support has created a deep sense of trust, making Donya feel comfortable discussing anything with her. This solid relationship has been instrumental in Donya's journey at the Club.

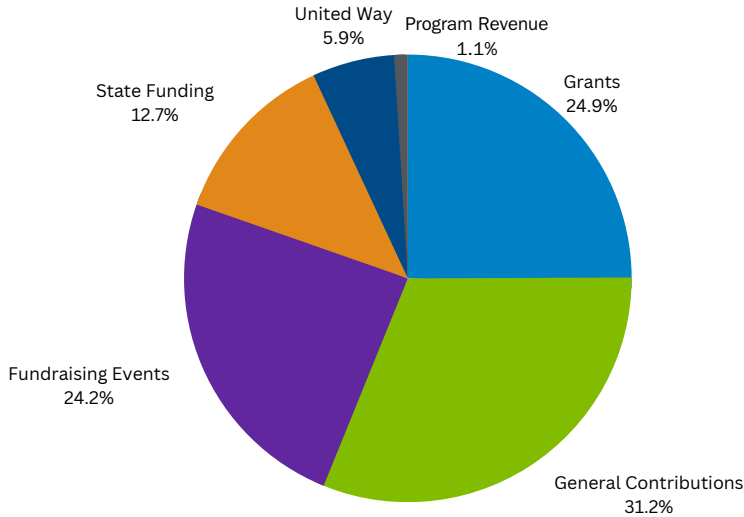
In addition to SMART Girls, Donya has been part of many amazing programs, like Chef's Club, Torch Club, Power Hour, Money Matters, Photography Club, and Career Academy. As a member, she enjoyed participating in all of these activities, and loves that she now gets to help lead them as a Junior Staff. "Running our SMART Girls program is a highlight," said Donya, "I get to help these girls in so many ways, from chatting about school to letting them know they have a support system at the Olivet Unit. Knowing I'm making a difference for kids who might be going through the same things I did is important to me." Donya appreciates what the Club has done for her and having the chance to do the same for the other Club kids.



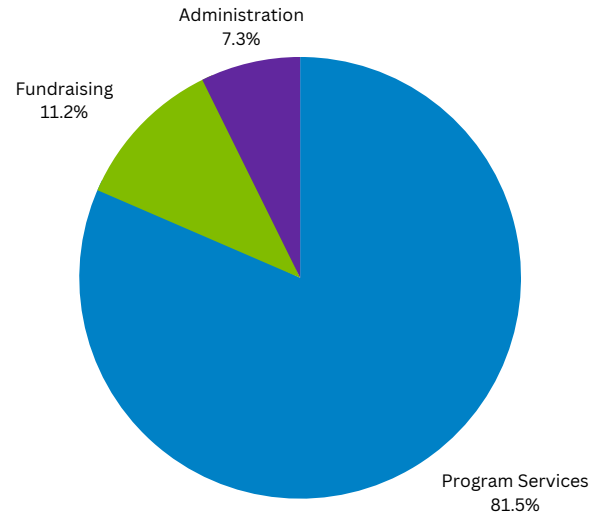
