Our Charleston location is operated under the loving supervision of our Hospitalier Sisters of Mercy and supported by our dedicated volunteers. The demand for our services has surged, particularly in light of the current challenges surrounding affordable housing. Over the past five years, our Greenville home has reached full capacity, serving more than 75 mothers, 28 children, and welcoming 45 babies into the world. Both St. Clare's Home locations offer comprehensive pre- and post-natal care, along with essential life skills training. Our classes cover a range of topics, including childbirth, parenting, nutrition, budgeting, and financial planning. We are committed to empowering our residents to pursue their education and career goals, providing mentorship to guide them along their journey.

At St. Clare's, we focus on meeting the physical, emotional, educational, and spiritual needs of our mothers, ensuring that they feel confident in caring for their children, managing a household, and achieving financial independence. While Crisis pregnancy centers do incredible work, pregnant women without stable living conditions truly need the supportive environment that St. Clare's Home provides. Our homes feature individual bedrooms, a full kitchen, a family room, a chapel, and a spacious yard and garden, all with 24-hour care and supervision.

Thanks to your generosity, we have been able to assist countless women and children through our outreach centers with clothing, diapers, baby items, and furniture. While we feel a sense of sadness when our moms depart, we are filled with joy as we witness them embark on their next chapters. Many have reunited with their families and their children's fathers, while others have chosen to live independently. We cherish the ongoing connections we maintain with them and look forward to seeing them at events we host in the home.
