ST. JOSEPH'S CATHOLIC SCHOOL

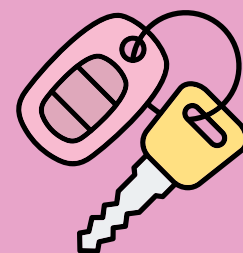
In Greenville focuses on Catholic stewardship by dedicating their time, talents, and treasure to St. Clare's Home.

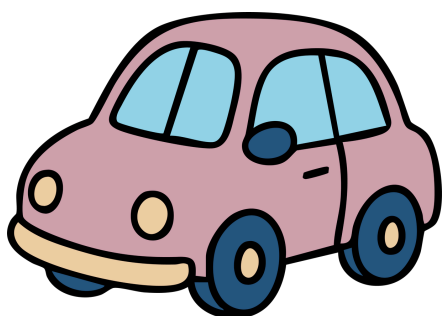

I came to St. Clare's in need of housing and assistance for myself and my son Myles who is four. I did not have consistent childcare or transportation. This was a barrier to employment and after trying to work at Walgreens close by, I found it too difficult to continue there. I persisted with my job search. I attended each class with Mr. Floyd and was able to perfect my resume and prepare through a mock interview. That, along with my experience, led me to find a remote job with TD Bank which allows for advancement. I was not only able to get set up at our home for the remote job, but I was also able to find childcare that works with my schedule. Through SC Works I received an ABC voucher and have since been blessed with the gift of a car from **St. Joseph's Catholic School** and a scholarship for my son through **First Steps** for school this year at St. Anthony of Padua. SC Works also provided me with gas cards to help get back and forth from training to daycare.

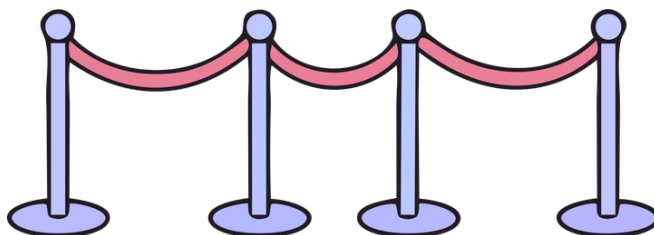

This position is responsible for the safety and security of the St. Clare's clients at the residential facilities of St. Clare's. The hours are a 48 hour shift every second or third weekend per month. This is perfect for anyone but also someone looking a second job. In addition, this position performs various program responsibilities including supervising and monitoring client, infant and children health and safety and contacting emergency medical personnel if needed.

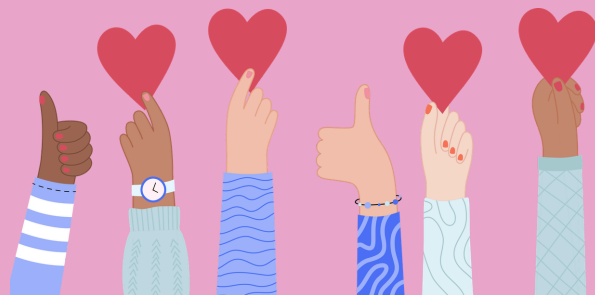
