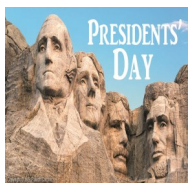

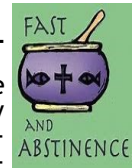

Every Saturday we have two priests administering this sacrament from 4pm to 5pm. Please come early and prepare in the silence of the church for this sacrament of peace and reconciliation.**Special Lenten Reconciliation March 16–27, 2026. Monday–Friday at 5:30 pm - 6 pm.****GENERAL NORMS ON ABSITINENCE AND FAST****General Norms:** All the faithful who have made First Communion are bound to worthily (celebrate the sacrament of reconciliation) receive Holy Communion during the Easter season.**On Abstinence:** Everyone fourteen years of age and older is bound to abstain from meat on Ash Wednesday, the Fridays of Lent and Good Friday.**On Fast:** Everyone eighteen years of age or older but under the age of sixty is also bound to fast on Ash Wednesday and Good Friday. On these two days, the law of fast allows only one full meal a day, but does not prohibit taking some food during the day, so long as this does not constitute another full meal. Drinking liquids during the day is permitted. When health or ability to work would be seriously affected, the law does not oblige. In doubt concerning fast or abstinence, you may consult any of the priests assigned in the parish or your confessor. In the spirit of penance, the faithful should not lightly excuse themselves from this obligation.*No penséis que he

THOUGHT FOR THE WEEK:

The readings for this Sunday remind us to follow God's commandments with our whole hearts. The first reading tells us that we must choose between good and evil. God lets us decide, but our choices have consequences. The second reading teaches that God's wisdom is greater than human wisdom. The gospel shows Jesus explaining the law. He does not remove it but calls us to live it fully. It is not enough to follow rules on the outside. We must also have love and goodness in our hearts.

Jesus teaches that obeying the law means more than just avoiding sin. We must also avoid anger, dishonesty, and selfishness. Faith is not just about rules but about living in a way that brings love and justice. Jesus wants us to follow the law because we love God and others, not just because we have to. This week, we should ask ourselves if we are only following rules or truly living God's teachings in our hearts.

PENSAMIENTO DE LA SEMANA:

Las lecturas de este Domingo nos recuerdan seguir los mandamientos de Dios con todo nuestro corazón. La primera lectura nos dice que debemos elegir entre el bien y el mal. Dios nos deja decidir, pero nuestras decisiones tienen consecuencias. La segunda lectura enseña que la sabiduría de Dios es mayor que la sabiduría humana. El evangelio muestra a Jesús explicando la ley. Él no la elimina, sino que nos llama a vivirla plenamente. No basta con seguir las reglas por fuera. También debemos tener amor y bondad en nuestro corazón.

Jesús enseña que obedecer la ley significa más que solo evitar el pecado. También debemos evitar la ira, la deshonestidad y el egoísmo. La fe no se trata solo de reglas, sino de vivir de una manera que fomente el amor y la justicia. Jesús quiere que sigamos la ley porque amamos a Dios y a los demás, no solo porque tengamos que hacerlo. Esta semana, debemos preguntarnos si solo estamos siguiendo reglas o realmente estamos viviendo las enseñanzas de Dios en nuestro corazón.

TODAY'S READINGS

First Reading – Sirach 15:15-20: You can choose to keep the commandments and trust in God. God sees everything and gives you the choice between life and death, good and evil.

Responsorial Psalm – Psalms 119: Blessed are they who follow the law of the Lord!

Second Reading – 1 Corinthians 2:6-10: We share God's hidden wisdom, planned for our glory, which the rulers did not understand. God's prepared blessings for those who love him, revealed through the Spirit who knows everything.

Gospel – Matthew 5:17-37: Jesus teaches his disciples to fulfill the law, surpass the righteousness of the scribes and Pharisees, avoid anger, lust, and false oaths, and always speak the truth.

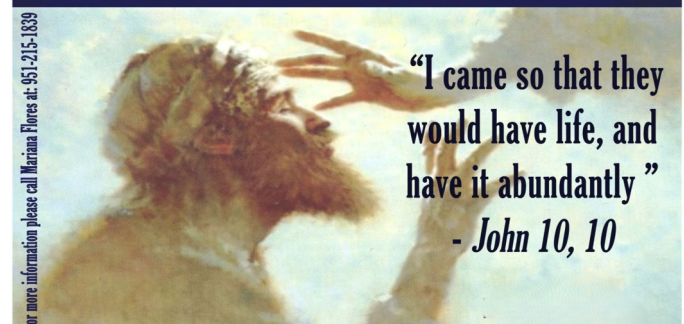

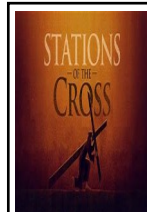
