



THOUGHT FOR THE WEEK:

On Palm Sunday, Jesus enters Jerusalem on a donkey. The people cheer and wave palm branches. They call Him a king. Later in the same Mass, we hear the story of His suffering and death. The crowd that praised Him later calls for Him to be crucified.

This Sunday helps us think about how quickly things can change. People can turn away from Jesus when things get hard. We are called to stay close to Him, even in hard times. Lent is almost over. This week, we remember His love and the cross. We get ready for Easter by walking with Him through His suffering.

PENSAMIENTO DE LA SEMANA:

El Domingo de Ramos, Jesús entra en Jerusalén montado en un burro. La gente lo aclama y agita ramas de palma. Lo llaman rey. Más tarde, en la misma Misa, escuchamos la historia de su sufrimiento y muerte. La multitud que lo aplaudió más tarde pide que sea crucificado.

Este Domingo nos ayuda a reflexionar sobre lo rápido que pueden cambiar las cosas. La gente puede alejarse de Jesús cuando las cosas se ponen difíciles. Estamos llamados a permanecer cerca de Él, incluso en los tiempos difíciles. La Cuaresma está casi terminando. Esta semana recordamos su amor y la cruz. Nos preparamos para la Pascua caminando con Él a través de Su sufrimiento.

TODAY'S READINGS

First Reading – Isaiah 50:4-7: The prophet Isaiah speaks of a servant of God who is a skilled teacher and obedient to God's will, even in the face of persecution and suffering. The servant trusts in God's protection and ultimately prevails over his oppressors.

Responsorial Psalm – Psalms 22: My God, my God, why have you abandoned me?

Second Reading – Philippians 2:6-11: This passage describes the selfless humility of Jesus Christ, who, despite being divine, chose to become human and submit to a humiliating death on a cross. As a result of his obedience, God exalted him and gave him a name above all others, that every knee should bow and every tongue confess that Jesus Christ is Lord.

Gospel – Matthew 26:14 – 27:66: The Passion reading describes the events leading up to Jesus' crucifixion and death. It includes Jesus' betrayal by Judas Iscariot, his arrest and trial before the high priest, his denial by Peter, his sentencing by Pilate, his crucifixion and death, and his burial in a tomb.

LECTURAS DE HOY

Primera Lectura – Isaías 50:4-7: El profeta Isaías habla de un siervo de Dios que es un maestro hábil y obediente a la voluntad de Dios, incluso frente a la persecución y el sufrimiento. El siervo confía en la protección de Dios y, en última instancia, prevalece sobre sus opresores.

Salmo Responsorial – Salmo 21: Dios mío, Dios mío, ¿por qué me has abandonado?

Segunda Lectura – Filipenses 2:6-11: Este pasaje describe la humildad desinteresada de Jesucristo, quien, a pesar de ser divino, eligió hacerse humano y someterse a una muerte humillante en la cruz. Como resultado de su obediencia, Dios lo exaltó y le dio un nombre sobre todos los demás, para que toda rodilla se doble y toda lengua confiese que Jesucristo es el Señor.

Evangelio – Mateo 26:14 – 27:66: La lectura de la Pasión describe los acontecimientos que llevaron a la crucifixión y muerte de Jesús. Incluye la traición a Jesús por Judas Iscariote, su arresto y juicio ante el sumo sacerdote, la negación de Pedro, su sentencia por Pilato, su crucifixión y muerte, y su sepultura en un sepulcro.
