

BASIC FUND

SCHOLARSHIP OPPORTUNITY

The BASIC Fund is a private funded scholarship program whose mission is to advance educational equity for low-income families by helping offset the cost of tuition at private schools in the Bay Area.

DO I QUALIFY?

You qualify if you meet ALL of the following requirements:

- 1.** Your child will be entering PreK-8th grade in a registered private school in Alameda, Contra Costa, Marin, Napa, San Francisco, San Mateo, Santa Clara, Solano or Sonoma counties in the fall.
- 2.** Your family meets the income eligibility guidelines (see basicfund.org for the guidelines in the How to Apply section).
- 3.** Your child is attending private school for the first time.
- 4.** Your child meets all academic and other admissions requirements of the private school that you choose.

Once you become a BASIC Fund family and continue to meet the eligibility guidelines, scholarships are renewable annually through your child's 8th grade year. All siblings can be included for consideration if desired. Scholarships are awarded on a first-come first-served basis.


Call the parish office for receiving the Anointing for one of your beloved ones who is sick.
