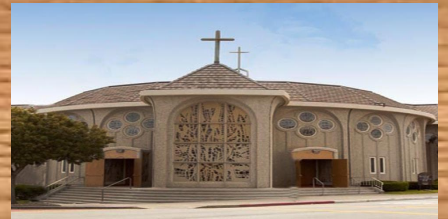




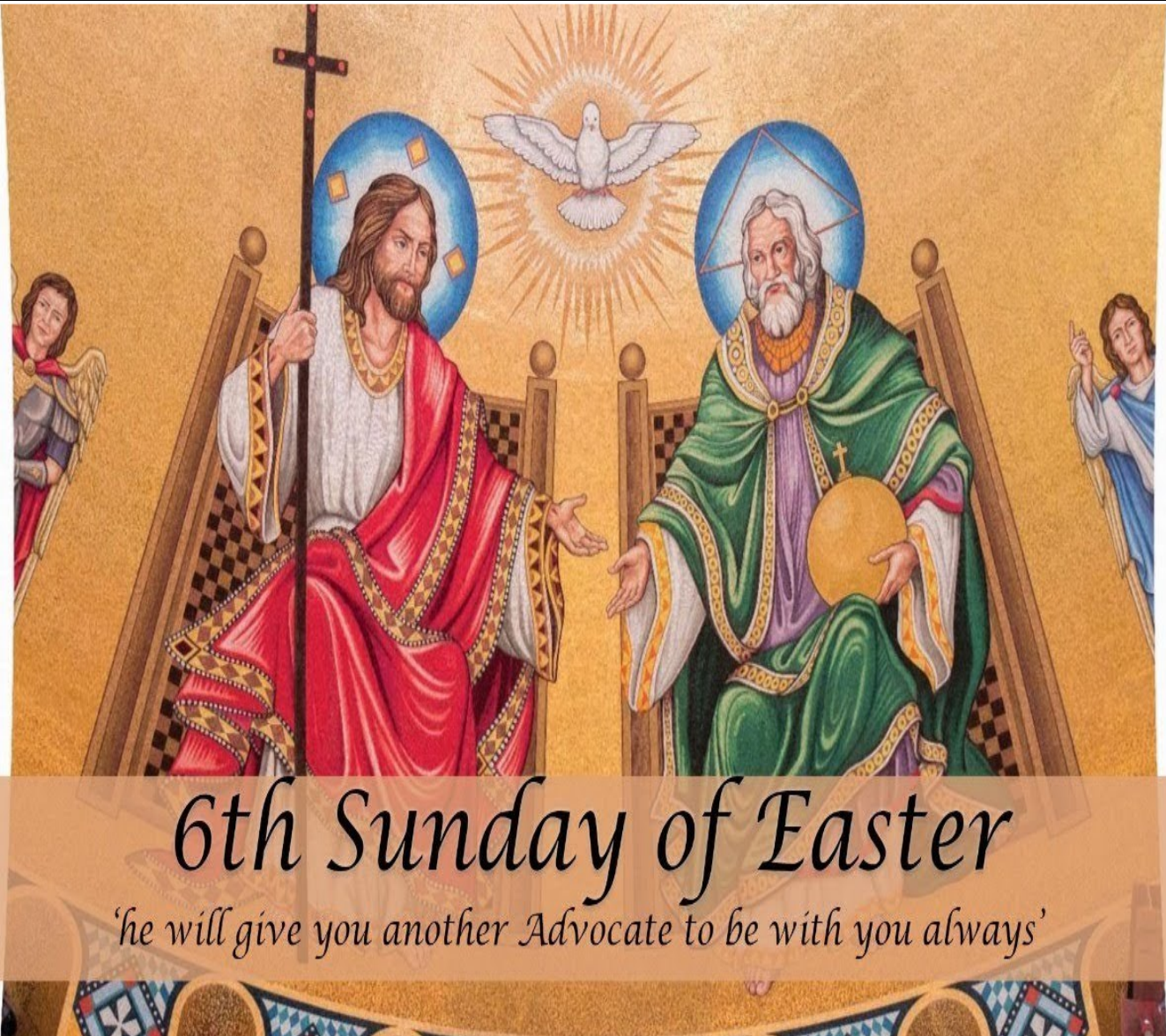

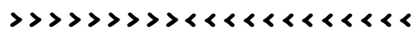

THOUGHT FOR THE WEEK:

The 6th Sunday of Easter Year A reminds us that God stays close to His people. The readings show faith spreading to new places. People hear the message of Jesus and believe. The psalm calls everyone to praise God with joy. Peter tells believers to speak about their hope with care and respect.

In the Gospel, Jesus promises the Holy Spirit. He says we will not be left alone. Loving Jesus means following His teachings. God gives strength through the Spirit. This Sunday reminds us to trust God's presence, live with love, and share our hope through our actions and words.

PENSAMIENTO DE LA SEMANA:

El sexto domingo de Pascua, Año A, nos recuerda que Dios permanece cerca de Su pueblo. Las lecturas muestran la fe extendiéndose a nuevos lugares. La gente escucha el mensaje de Jesús y cree. El salmo llama a todos a alabar a Dios con alegría. Pedro dice a los creyentes que hablen de su esperanza con cuidado y respeto.

En el Evangelio, Jesús promete el Espíritu Santo. Él dice que no seremos dejados solos. Amar a Jesús significa seguir Sus enseñanzas. Dios da fuerza a través del Espíritu. Este domingo nos recuerda confiar en la presencia de Dios, vivir con amor y compartir nuestra esperanza a través de nuestras acciones y palabras.

TODAY'S READINGS

First Reading – Acts 8:5-8, 14-17: Philip goes to Samaria and preaches the word of God to the people, performing many miraculous signs and healings, which resulted in many people believing and being baptized. Peter and John arrive in Samaria and prayed for the new believers, laying their hands on them, and they received the Holy Spirit.

Responsorial Psalm – Psalm 66: Let all the earth cry out to God with joy.

Second Reading – 1 Peter 3:15-18: Peter instructs believers to always be ready to give a defense of their faith with gentleness and respect, even in the face of persecution. He then reminds them of the example of Christ, who suffered and died for our sins, but was raised to life by the power of God.

Gospel – John 14:15-21: Jesus promises his disciples that if they love Him, they will keep His commandments, and He will ask the Father to send them the Advocate, the Holy Spirit, to be with them forever. He also promises that He will come to them and reveal Himself to them, and whoever loves Him and keeps His word will be loved by the Father, and they will dwell with Him.

LECTURAS DE HOY

Primera Lectura – Hechos 8:5-8, 14-17: Felipe va a Samaria y predica la palabra de Dios al pueblo, realizando muchos signos milagrosos y sanidades, lo que resultó en que muchas personas creyeran y fueran bautizadas. Pedro y Juan llegan a Samaria y oran por los nuevos creyentes, imponiéndoles las manos, y ellos recibieron el Espíritu Santo.

Salmo Responsorial – Salmo 65: Las obras del Señor son admirables. Aleluya.

Segunda Lectura – 1 Pedro 3:15-18: Pedro instruye a los creyentes a estar siempre listos para dar una defensa de su fe con gentileza y respeto, incluso frente a la persecución. Luego les recuerda el ejemplo de Cristo, quien sufrió y murió por nuestros pecados, pero fue resucitado a la vida por el poder de Dios.

Evangelio – Juan 14:15-21: Jesús promete a sus discípulos que si Lo aman, guardarán Sus mandamientos, y Él pedirá al Padre que les envíe al Consolador, el Espíritu Santo, para estar con ellos para siempre. También promete que Él vendrá a ellos y se revelará a ellos, y quien Lo ame y guarde Su palabra será amado por el Padre, y ellos morarán con Él.
