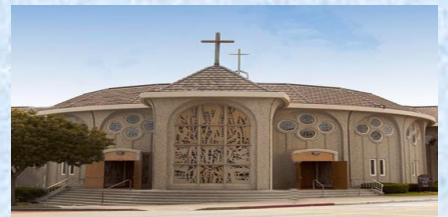

Call the parish office and bring the required documents to set the wedding date. Ordinarily preparations will take at least six months.

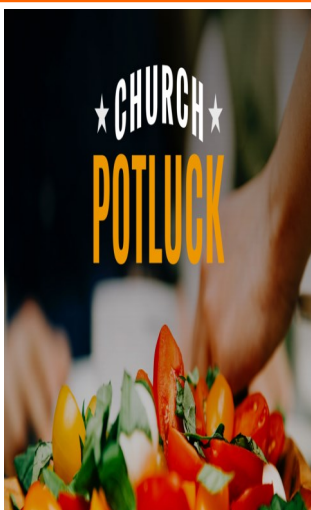

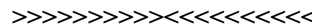

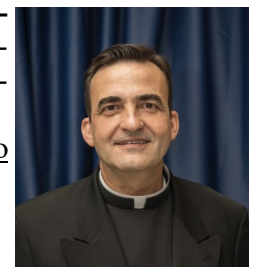

THOUGHT FOR THE WEEK:

Pentecost Year A celebrates the coming of the Holy Spirit. The disciples receive the Spirit with wind and fire. They speak in many languages. People from many places understand the message. This shows that the Good News is for everyone. The Spirit gives new life and brings people together.

The Spirit is still with us today. The readings show the Spirit helping us pray and giving us strength. Jesus sends His followers to forgive and to share peace. Each person has gifts to serve others. Pentecost reminds us to welcome the Spirit, live with courage, and work together as one body in Christ.

PENSAMIENTO DE LA SEMANA:

El Pentecostés del Año A celebra la venida del Espíritu Santo. Los discípulos reciben al Espíritu con viento y fuego. Hablan en muchos idiomas. Personas de muchos lugares entienden el mensaje. Esto muestra que la Buena Nueva es para todos. El Espíritu da nueva vida y une a las personas.

TODAY'S READINGS

First Reading – Acts 2:1-11: At Pentecost, disciples received the Holy Spirit, speaking in diverse languages. A crowd, amazed, heard them in their own tongues, witnessing God's wonders transcending language barriers.

Responsorial Psalm – Psalm 104: Lord, send out your Spirit, and renew the face of the earth.

Second Reading – 1 Corinthians 12:3B-7, 12-13: Only by the Holy Spirit can one say, "Jesus is Lord." Despite various gifts, ways of service, and workings, they all originate from one Spirit, serving the common good and uniting us as one body in Christ.

Gospel – John 20:19-23: Jesus appears to his disciples after his resurrection. He greets them with peace, shows them his wounds, and then breathes on them, giving them the gift of the Holy Spirit and commissioning them to forgive sins.

LECTURAS DE HOY

Primera Lectura – Hechos 2:1-11: En Pentecostés, los discípulos recibieron el Espíritu Santo, hablando en diversos idiomas. Una multitud, asombrada, los escuchaba en sus propias lenguas, siendo testigo de las maravillas de Dios que trascienden las barreras del idioma.

Salmo Responsorial – Salmo 103: Envía, Señor, tu Espíritu a renovar la tierra. Aleluya.

Segunda Lectura – 1 Corintios 12:3B-7, 12-13: Solo por el Espíritu Santo se puede decir: "Jesús es Señor." A pesar de los diversos dones, formas de servicio y operaciones, todos provienen de un solo Espíritu, sirviendo al bien común y uniéndonos como un solo cuerpo en Cristo.

Evangelio – Juan 20:19-23: Jesús se aparece a sus discípulos después de su resurrección. Los saluda con paz, les muestra sus heridas y luego sopla sobre ellos, dándoles el don del Espíritu Santo y encargándoles perdonar los pecados.
