



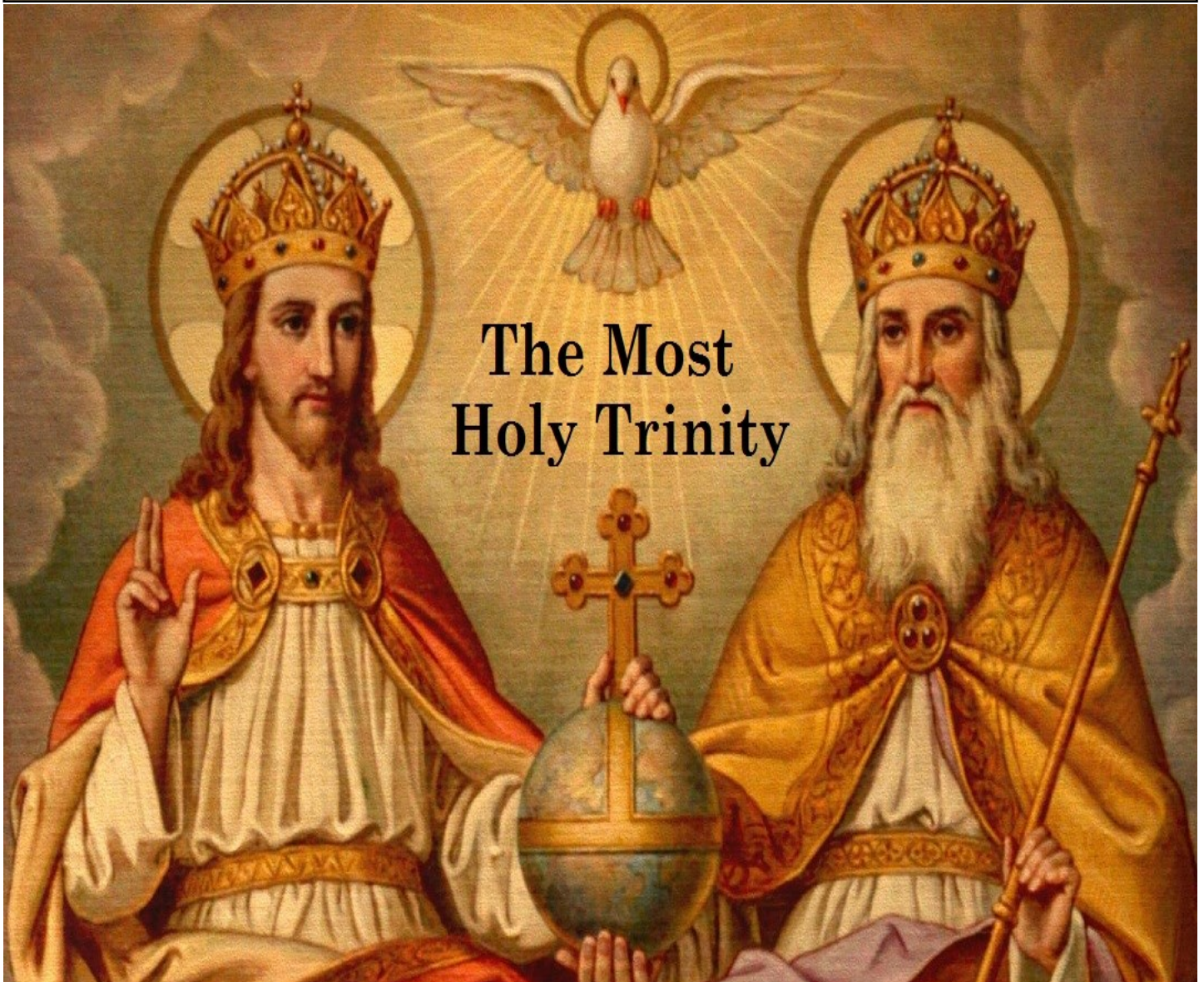

**THOUGHT FOR THE WEEK:**

Trinity Sunday Year A invites us to think about God as Father, Son, and Holy Spirit. The readings show a God who is kind, patient, and full of care. God speaks to Moses with mercy. Creation gives praise. Paul calls people to live in peace. These words remind us that God stays close to His people.

The Gospel tells us that God loves the world and sent His Son to save us. Faith opens the door to new life. The Holy Spirit helps us grow and stay united. This Sunday calls us to trust God, live in peace, and share His love with others.

**TODAY'S READINGS**

**First Reading** – Exodus 34:4B-6, 8-9: God appears to Moses and speaks about His character. He is kind, patient, full of love, and ready to forgive, but He also brings justice. Moses bows down and worships Him.

**Responsorial Psalm** – Daniel 3: Glory and praise for ever.

**Second Reading** – 2 Corinthians 13:11-13: Paul encourages the people to live in peace and unity. He blesses them with the grace of Jesus, the love of God, and the friendship of the Holy Spirit.

**Gospel** – John 3:16-18: Jesus tells Nicodemus that God loves the world so much that He sent His Son to bring eternal life. Those who believe in Jesus will be saved, but those who do not believe miss out on this gift.

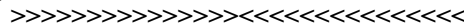
