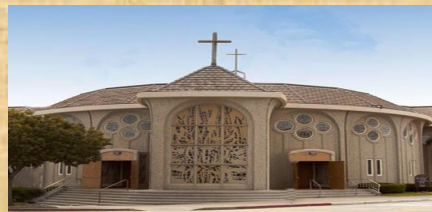

THOUGHT FOR THE WEEK:

The Mass readings for the 3rd Sunday of Easter Year C emphasize the importance of evangelization, recognizing Jesus, enduring suffering for the gospel, and the universal praise of God by all creation. The apostles courageously proclaim the Good News despite persecution, all creatures unite in declaring Jesus as king, and Peter recognizes Jesus after a miraculous catch of fish.

PENSAMIENTO DE LA SEMANA:

Las lecturas de la Misa para el 3er Domingo de Pascua del Año C enfatizan la importancia de la evangelización, el reconocimiento de Jesús, el sufrimiento soportable por el evangelio y la alabanza universal de Dios por toda la creación. Los apóstoles proclaman valientemente la Buena Nueva a pesar de la persecución, todas las criaturas se unen para declarar a Jesús como rey, y Pedro reconoce a Jesús después de una pesca milagrosa.

TODAY'S READINGS

First Reading – Acts 5:27-32, 40B-41: The apostles, questioned by the high priest, insisted on obeying God and rejoiced in their suffering for Jesus.

Responsorial Psalm – Psalm 30: I will praise you, Lord, for you have rescued me. *Or*: Alleluia.

Second Reading – Revelation 5:11-14: I saw countless angels praising the Lamb, and every creature joined in worship, giving honor and glory to God and the Lamb forever.

Gospel – John 21:1-19: Jesus appeared to his disciples, guiding them to a miraculous catch. He shared breakfast and asked Peter three times if he loved him, instructing him to care for his followers.

LECTURAS DE HOY

Primera Lectura – Hechos 5:27-32, 40B-41: Los apóstoles, interrogados por el sumo sacerdote, insistieron en obedecer a Dios y se regocijaron en su sufrimiento por Jesús.

Salmo Responsorial – Salmo 29: Te alabaré, Señor, eternamente. Aleluya.

Segunda Lectura – Apocalipsis 5:11-14: Vi a innumerables ángeles alabando al Cordero, y todas las criaturas se unieron en adoración, dando honor y gloria a Dios y al Cordero para siempre.

Evangelio – Juan 21:1-19: Jesús se apareció a sus discípulos, guiándolos a una pesca milagrosa. Compartió el desayuno y le preguntó a Pedro tres veces si lo amaba, instruyéndole que cuidara de sus seguidores.
