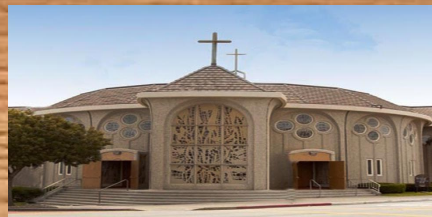

THOUGHT FOR THE WEEK:

The 27th Sunday in Ordinary Time Year C speaks about faith, trust, and serving others. Faith does not need to be big to be real. Even a little faith, if it is true, can do great things. Faith grows when we trust God, even when life feels unfair or hard. It means waiting for God's plan and believing He is working, even if we cannot see it yet.

This Sunday also speaks about using the gifts God has given us. Each person has something to offer, and we should use these gifts to help others. Serving God is not about seeking praise or rewards. It is about doing what is right because it is what God asks of us. Faith and service belong together. When we trust God and serve with love, we show our faith in simple, everyday ways.

PENSAMIENTO DE LA SEMANA:

El 27º Domingo del Tiempo Ordinario, Año C, habla sobre la fe, la confianza y el servicio a los demás. La fe no necesita ser grande para ser real. Incluso una pequeña fe, si es verdadera, puede hacer grandes cosas. La fe crece cuando confiamos en Dios, incluso cuando la vida parece injusta o difícil. Significa esperar el plan de Dios y creer que Él está obrando, aunque aún no podamos verlo.

Este Domingo también habla sobre usar los dones que Dios nos ha dado. Cada persona tiene algo que ofrecer, y debemos usar estos dones para ayudar a los demás. Servir a Dios no se trata de buscar elogios o recompensas. Se trata de hacer lo correcto porque es lo que Dios nos pide. La fe y el servicio van juntos. Cuando confiamos en Dios y servimos con amor, mostramos nuestra fe de maneras simples y cotidianas.

TODAY'S READINGS

First Reading – Habakkuk 1:2-3; 2:2-4: Despite witnessing violence and injustice, the plea for divine intervention is met with God's instruction to record a future vision that promises fulfillment and vindicates the just who live by faith.

Responsorial Psalm – Psalm 95: If today you hear his voice, harden not your hearts.

Second Reading – 2 Timothy 1:6-8, 13-14: Reignite the divine gift within you, embracing God's spirit of power, love, and discipline, and steadfastly proclaim your faith, guided and protected by the Holy Spirit.

Gospel – Luke 17:5-10: Jesus teaches that even a small amount of faith can achieve great things and compares this to a servant's duty, emphasizing that fulfilling obligations is simply doing what is expected.

LECTURAS DE HOY

Primera Lectura – Habacuc 1:2-3; 2:2-4: A pesar de presenciar violencia e injusticia, la súplica por la intervención divina se encuentra con la instrucción de Dios de registrar una visión futura que promete cumplimiento y vindica a los justos que viven por fe.

Salmo Responsorial – Salmo 94: Señor, que no seamos sordos a tu voz.

Segunda Lectura – 2 Timoteo 1:6-8, 13-14: Aviva el don divino que hay en ti, abrazando el espíritu de poder, amor y disciplina de Dios, y proclama tu fe con firmeza, guiado y protegido por el Espíritu Santo.

Evangelio – Lucas 17:5-10: Jesús enseña que incluso una pequeña cantidad de fe puede lograr grandes cosas y compara esto con el deber de un siervo, enfatizando que cumplir con las obligaciones es simplemente hacer lo que se espera.
