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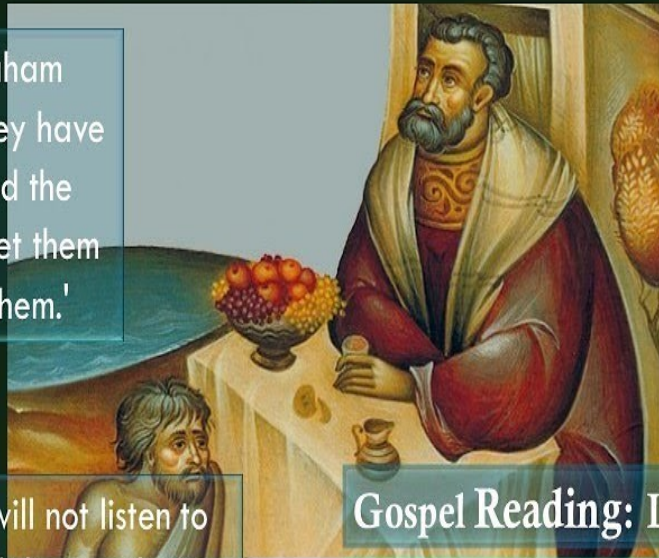

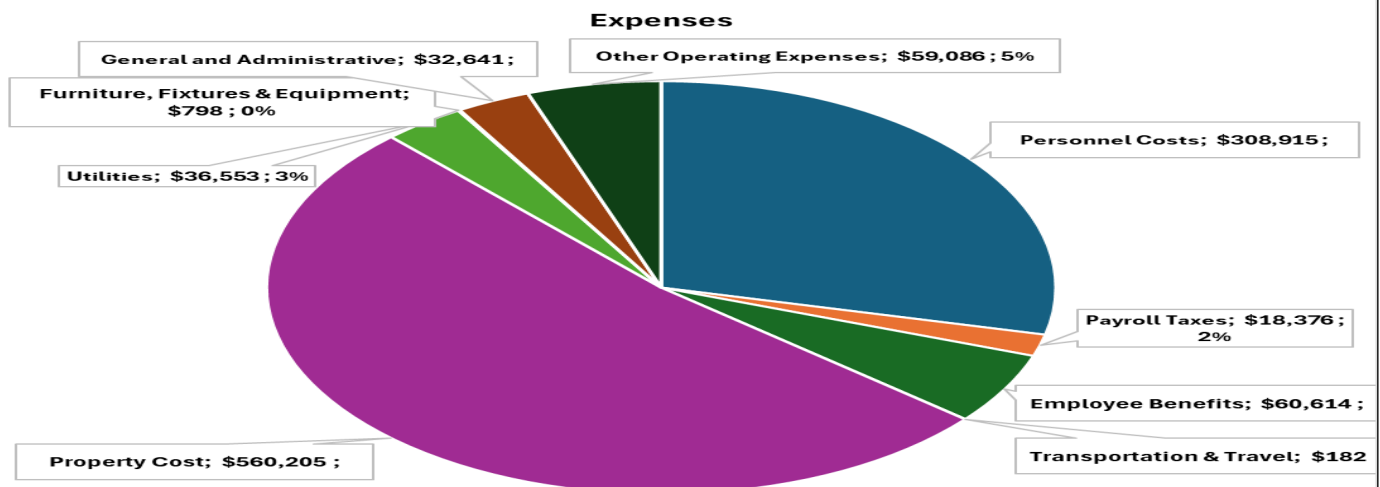
PENSAMIENTO DE LA SEMANA:

TODAY'S READINGS

First Reading – Amos 6:1A, 4-7: God condemns those living in luxury and indifference in Zion, foretelling their exile and the end of their extravagant celebrations.

Responsorial Psalm – Psalm 146: Praise the Lord,
my soul!

Second Reading – 1 Timothy 6:11-16: A man of God is urged to pursue virtues and hold onto eternal life, keeping commandments until Christ's return, honoring the immortal, unseen Sovereign.

Gospel – Luke 16:19-31: Jesus narrated a parable contrasting a rich man's luxurious life with Lazarus, a destitute man. After death, Lazarus found comfort with Abraham, while the rich man suffered. The rich man's plea for relief and a warning for his brothers was denied, emphasizing the sufficiency of Moses and the prophets' teachings.

LECTURAS DE HOY

Primera Lectura – Amós 6:1A, 4-7: Dios condena a aquellos que viven en lujo e indiferencia en Sion, prediciendo su exilio y el final de sus celebraciones extravagantes.

Salmo Responsorial – Salmo 145: Alabemos al Señor, que viene a salvarnos.

Segunda Lectura – 1 Timoteo 6:11-16: Se insta a un hombre de Dios a perseguir virtudes y aferrarse a la vida eterna, guardando los mandamientos hasta el regreso de Cristo, honrando al Soberano inmortal e invisible.

Evangelio – Lucas 16:19-31: Jesús narró una parábola contrastando la vida lujosa de un hombre rico con la de Lázaro, un hombre indigente. Después de la muerte, Lázaro encontró consuelo con Abraham, mientras que el hombre rico sufría. La súplica del hombre rico por alivio y una advertencia para sus hermanos fueron denegadas, enfatizando la suficiencia de las enseñanzas de Moisés y los profetas.
