## Price List of Services and Merchandise

## MINIMUM SERVICES

The Minimum Services charge represents the minimum, non-declinable services required to facilitate the disposition of a deceased person, whether by cremation or burial.

This minimum service charge is applicable to every family we serve and includes transferring the deceased from the place of death or other location to our facility, where the deceased will be placed in a casket/cremation container of your choosing and securely held until the necessary documentation is completed for burial or cremation, as applicable. Once the required documentation is ready (i.e. death has been registered and if applicable, the coroner's certificate for cremation has been

obtained), the deceased is transported in a service van or SUV to the cemetery or crematorium at the earliest practicable opportunity or at a scheduled time, as applicable.

### What is NOT included in the above Minimum Services:

- any supplies, such as a casket/cremation container, urn, outer burial container, stationery, etc.
- any additional services that may be selected, such as embalming, visitation, and funeral services
- the initial transfer of the remains from a location other than an institution
- additional mileage fees beyond 65 km
- pacemaker / other implant removal, if applicable
- disbursements to be paid to third parties on your behalf.

## ADDITIONAL SERVICE CHOICES

### Additional body preparation services

You may wish to view your loved one prior to burial or cremation. Consider choosing "identification of remains" or embalming, as it might afford a more peaceful final viewing experience. Embalming is not legally required, but may be recommended to preserve the body between the time of death and final disposition.

### Visitation

These are informal gathering periods that allow family and friends to come and pay their respects and offer comfort to a grieving family.

### Funeral service

This is a ceremony with the body present in a casket. A funeral service can be religious or non-denominational and can be held in various places, including within our premises, at a place of worship, a venue such as a hall, or at the graveside.

### Memorial service or Celebration of life

This is a service to commemorate the deceased, which takes place after the body has been cremated. The cremated remains may or may not be present, as chosen by you. We are proud to have a Certified Funeral Celebrant on staff to help honour your loved one.

## COMMONLY SELECTED SERVICES

### A: TRADITIONAL SERVICE

Embalming with two periods of visitation at our premises, with a funeral service the following day at a church or other location off-site, and procession to a local cemetery, or transfer to the crematorium.

### B: MEMORIAL SERVICE WITH VISITATION

Cremation with two periods of visitation at our premises, with a funeral service the following day at a church or other location off-site with use of the funeral ark, and procession to a local cemetery.

### C: SAME DAY MEMORIAL SERVICE

Cremation with a period of visitation for 2 hours followed immediately by a memorial service at our premises, with the use of the funeral ark.

### D: MEMORIAL SERVICE OFF-SITE

Cremation with a memorial service at a church or other location off-site with the use of the funeral ark, and procession to a local cemetery.

### E: DIRECT CREMATION

Cremation with no visitation, nor memorial service.

## DESCRIPTION OF SERVICES AND FEES

Any services marked with an asterisk (\*) are the minimum services required to carry out a direct burial or cremation. Services such as embalming, visitation, and ceremonies are optional. You may choose only the services you desire.

**\* Basic professional services** ..... \$ 1,460

Professional consultation with a licensed funeral director in order to create a meaningful and personalized funeral service, including but not limited to: expert advice on choices to meet your needs; drafting obituaries; posting information on our website; photo retouching and editing; and advice regarding possible government benefits. Also includes coordination of all activities, rites, and ceremonies before, during, and after they have been provided by us and/or by third-party suppliers, such as: clergy; cemetery staff; crematorium personnel; and any other persons or organizations that must be contacted. Our firm provides the services of a licensed funeral director, as well as support staff, who are available 365 days a year, 24 hours per day, to respond to the needs of families. We do not charge additional fees for services rendered after normal business hours, nor on statutory holidays, with the exception of spring burials and delayed funerals (see page 7). Includes certain overhead expenses such as: maintenance and utilities; accounting and office administration; insurance; and updates to our network and website. It also includes the handling of all in memoriam donations and masses.

**\* Documentation** ..... \$ 370

Consists of procuring, completing, and recording of all necessary documents to carry out the services and supplies requested, including, but not limited to, municipal, regional, and provincial authorities as well as with the coroner, clergy, cemetery, crematorium, media outlets, and funeral home registers. We also provide 5 copies of the Funeral Director's Proof of Death for purposes of estate settlement.

**\* Minimum preparation of remains** (requires *Facilities for preparation/embalming/shelter*) ..... \$ 155

This service is a minimum requirement. The body is verified for personal effects (which will be returned to the authorized representative, unless otherwise instructed) and the body is placed into the casket/cremation container selected.

**OR**

**Private family time** (requires *Facilities for preparation/embalming/shelter*) ..... \$ 310

This service includes those described in "Minimum preparation of remains" above, plus bathing; the setting of facial features; dressing; and application of cosmetics, if desired. Allows private quiet time with the deceased, with up to 5 family members, for up to 30 minutes, in the visitation room, to identify the remains, at the convenience of the funeral home. This service is intended for purposes of identification only and not for visitation.

**OR**

**Embalming** (requires *Facilities for preparation/embalming/shelter*) ..... \$ 550

Embalming is the process of replacing blood and bodily fluids with chemical preservatives. It is a process of sanitation, restoration, and temporary preservation. This service includes those described in "Private family time" above, plus basic hairstyling.

**Autopsy embalming** ..... \$ 650

**Staff services for visitation** (requires *Facilities for visitation*) ..... \$ 450

Staff to coordinate and oversee the visitation within our premises for a total of 6 hours, maximum. Includes but is not limited to setting up the room (floral arrangements, pictures, memorabilia, casket/urn); and greeting and directing visitors. Includes professional video tribute displayed on a large television.

**Staff services for ceremony** ..... \$ 410

One licensed funeral director and assistants to coordinate and oversee the ceremony or informal gathering within our premises, or at an off-site location, for a period of 3 hours, maximum. Includes but is not limited to setting up the room/area (floral arrangements, pictures, memorabilia, casket/urn); the use of minimum equipment as required; and greeting and directing visitors. Includes professional video tribute displayed on a large television within our premises.

**Staff services for graveside service**..... \$ 235  
One funeral director to coordinate and oversee the graveside committal service (within 65 km), for a period of 1 hour, maximum.

## FACILITIES

**\* Facilities for preparation/embalming/shelter** ..... \$ 285  
A secure and private room used to prepare, embalm, and/or shelter the body until the time of burial, cremation, or alternative disposition. This charge applies whenever the body is in our facility. This room is not open to the public. It includes a specialized ventilation system, as well as all the necessary equipment and PPE for sanitary care and embalming. A supplementary charge of \$100 per day (every 24 hours) will be applied after the first 48 hours.

**Facilities for visitation** (requires *Staff services for visitation*)..... \$ 450  
Use of designated facilities for visitation for a total of no more than 6 hours. Includes but is not limited to cleaning and sanitizing; and the provision of necessary equipment, A/V system, and lounge services (coffee and tea).

**Facilities for ceremony:** (requires *Staff services for ceremony*) ..... \$ 450  
Use of designated facilities for the ceremony or informal gathering for a period of no more than 3 hours. Includes but is not limited to cleaning and sanitizing; and the provision of necessary equipment, A/V system, and lounge services (coffee and tea).

## TRANSPORTATION

### **\* Removal and transfer**

Transfer of the remains from the place of death to the funeral home, using an unmarked vehicle, specialized equipment, and PPE. Each additional staff member required will be charged at the rate of \$100 per hour. Includes the transfer from the funeral home to Guenette Crematorium or to a cemetery (within 65 km). Any subsequent transfers will incur an additional fee.

**Institution** (within 65 km) ..... \$ 300  
Includes one staff member.

**Residence** (within 65 km)..... \$ 400  
Includes two staff members.

**Additional mileage** (beyond 65 km) .....\$ 300 base fee  
Includes meal and accommodation allowance. Base fee plus mileage fee as follows:  
66 km to 700 km = \$ 1.10 per kilometre travelled  
701 km and above = \$ 0.85 per kilometre travelled

**\* Administration vehicle**..... \$ 145  
General duty vehicle used to register the death, repatriate cremated remains from the crematorium, make off-site arrangements, delivery of equipment and floral tributes, etc.

**Hearse for ceremony**..... \$ 295  
Use of the funeral coach to the place of worship and/or cemetery (within 65 km).

**Lead car / Pallbearer's car** ..... \$ 145  
Use of the lead car for the funeral director and pallbearers to the place of worship and/or cemetery (within 65 km). Use of this car keeps the six acting pallbearers together at all times, thus allowing for better coordination of their assistance.

**Funeral Director's Proof of Death** ..... \$ 12  
Our proofs of death are usually accepted for most estate settlement purposes, but sometimes a provincial Death Certificate will be necessary and is available from the Office of the Registrar General.

**Funeral Director's Proof of Death (25 years)** ..... \$ 25  
Proof of death for a person who passed away more than 25 years ago.

**Estate Fraud Protection** ..... \$ 95  
Daily notification to credit reporting agencies by a fraud specialist, helping safeguard your loved one's estate against identity theft and security breaches.

**Register Book** ..... \$ 70  
Personalized register book by Vaella.

**Acknowledgement cards (25)** ..... \$ 22  
Cream coloured thank you cards available in English or French by Vaella.

**Crucifix** ..... \$ 28  
Brass crucifix approximately 9" (23 cm) in length

**Candle** ..... \$ 26.55  
Personalized memorial candle with your choice of background.

**Memorial cards** ..... \$ 1.13 each  
Simple memorial cards printed on white cardstock, with your choice of poem or prayer. Minimum purchase of 24 cards, in multiples of 8.

**Memorial cards – Plastic** ..... \$ 2.35 each  
Fully personalized memorial cards printed on a plastic card. Personalization includes your choice of background, and poem or prayer. Minimum purchase of 25 cards.

**Bookmarks** ..... \$ 3.30 each  
Fully personalized and individually laminated bookmarks. Personalization includes your choice of background, and poem or prayer. Minimum purchase of 24 bookmarks, in multiples of 4.

**Large Memorial Picture Frame** ..... \$ 65  
Black frame with an 8" x 10" photo (with mat) of your loved one, printed by us.

**Small Memorial Picture Frame** ..... \$ 55  
Black frame with either an 8" x 10" photo (without mat) , or a 5" x 7" photo (with mat) of your loved one, printed by us.

**Batesville commemorative plaque** ..... \$ 130  
Personalized wooden plaque for mounting a LifeSymbols® corner or LifeStories® design.

**Batesville LifeSymbols® corner / LifeStories® medallion** ..... \$ 45  
Added to the corners of a casket or to an urn, the LifeSymbols® and LifeStories® designs reflect the personality, spirit, and interests of a loved one.

**Livestreaming** ..... \$ 125  
Livestreaming and recording of the funeral service at our premises for those who are unable to attend in person.

<b>Funeral Celebrant</b> .....	\$ 325
Our Certified Funeral Celebrant has been specifically trained to provide a funeral service, memorial service or tribute that is completely personal, incorporating those unique stories, songs, and experiences that defined the deceased, after consultation and a sharing time with the family and loved ones.	
<b>Funeral ark</b> .....	no fee
A solid oak and glass case designed to display the urn at the visitation and/or funeral service. The use of the Funeral Ark incurs no charge when available; however, use of the Hearse is required when transported to a church or a location other than the funeral establishment.	
<b>Equipment and setup off-site</b> .....	\$ 750
Deliver, set up and use of equipment necessary for visitation at a location other than the funeral establishment.	
<b>Staff services for visitation off-site</b> .....	\$ 600
Staff to coordinate and oversee the visitation or informal gathering for a total of no more than <u>6 hours</u> at a location other than the funeral establishment. Includes professional tribute video displayed on a large television.	
<b>* Removal of pacemaker or other implant</b> .....	\$ 100
This procedure is mandatory prior to cremating a body that contains a pacemaker or other implant and must be carried out by a licensed funeral director. Includes disposal of such device. If a person was undergoing brachytherapy (radioactive theraseeds) or radioisotope treatments before death, cremation may not be possible; please speak with one of our funeral directors for more information.	
<b>Plastic pouch</b> .....	\$ 65
A plastic body pouch may be necessary, or required by law, in certain circumstances.	
<b>Professional restorative procedures</b> .....	\$ 70/hour
In some circumstances, additional restorative efforts beyond those captured in the standard embalming procedure are necessary to enhance the appearance of the deceased. In such cases, the funeral director will discuss the available choices and their cost. Professional restorative procedures will be charged per hour.	
<b>Other preparation of deceased</b> .....	\$ 305
Encompasses the preparation of a deceased from other facilities. This may include dressing, the application of cosmetics, hairdressing, and casketing.	
<b>Refundable deposit for cremated remains</b> .....	\$ 350
When human remains are to be cremated, payment of a refundable deposit may be required. If the cremated remains are not claimed within one year of the cremation, the deposit may be used to inter the cremated remains in common ground in a cemetery of the funeral home's choosing. If the cremated remains are claimed before they are interred, the deposit will be refunded.	
<b>Spring interment</b> .....	\$ 235
Our assistance at the cemetery immediately following the ceremony is included. This does not apply to a death that occurred during the winter months when the cemetery is not in operation; the funeral home will assist at the spring interment on weekdays during the month of May, at no additional charge. <b>A spring interment held on a weekend, statutory holiday or after the month of May will incur the additional charge.</b>	
<b>Delayed funeral</b> .....	\$ 250
Additional fee for Staff services for visitation, ceremony, and/or graveside service on a weekend or statutory holiday when there is <b>a delay of more than 10 days</b> from the date of death. This fee will apply to each event that incurs a <i>Staff services</i> charge.	
<b>Additional visitation/ceremony time</b> .....	\$ 100/hour
Overtime fee charged per hour when visitation and/or ceremony time surpasses the agreed upon hours as described in the Funeral Service Contract.

## POSSIBLE DISBURSEMENTS

Disbursements are items arranged for and possibly paid for on your behalf by the funeral home to third party providers. Any prices quoted in this section are subject to change without notice. Such items include but are not limited to:

**Coroner's fee** ..... \$ 75

This is a provincially set fee charged by the coroner for issuing a certificate that allows for cremation or out of province shipping to take place.

**BAO Consumer protection fee** ..... \$ 30

This set fee is charged by the Bereavement Authority of Ontario for every burial, scattering, cremation, hydrolysis, and death registration in the province of Ontario.

**Interment fees** ..... Varies

These fees are charged by the cemetery for opening and closing of the grave or columbarium.

**Municipal death registration fee** ..... \$ 0

This is a fee charged by the local municipality to register the death on behalf of the Province of Ontario. The municipality issues a burial permit, then forwards the registration documents to the Office of the Registrar General in Thunder Bay.

**Clergy / church / celebrant / musician honorarium** ..... Varies

This is an amount paid to the clergy, church, celebrant, and/or musician for their services. In some cases, the amount is set by the third-party, in others it is an amount to be determined by you.

**Media notices** ..... Varies

These are charges for death notices in newspapers, radio stations, or other media outlets.

The funeral home does not accept disbursements on prearrangement contracts.

## CASKETS

The following caskets listed are those generally available. Unless otherwise noted, all caskets listed are standard adult size.

### Minimum requirements for a casket:

For burial: The least expensive cloth casket is suitable and is required by most cemeteries' by-laws for burial, in the interest of the health and safety of the workers involved in the burial process. A metal casket may also be used for burial.

For cremation: A body must be presented to the crematorium in a rigid, leak-proof casket that is made of a combustible material, such as wood or cardboard. Caskets containing non-flammable, hazardous material or chlorinated or fibre-reinforced plastic, other than incidental metal, cannot be used for cremation. *Caskets marked with an asterisk (\*) are not suitable for cremation.*

## VAULTS

The outer containers for burial listed below are for standard adult size caskets and for urns.

You do not have to purchase a vault, unless the Medical Officer of Health has made the use of vaults and grave liners mandatory in the entire cemetery. A cemetery operator may designate a specific area in the cemetery where containers for burial are required; however, the operator must have another area where containers for burial are not required, so that consumers have a choice. A vault or grave liner may be recommended when there are environmental conditions such as poor drainage, or for practical or aesthetic reasons.

## By-law and Price List

This by-law sets out the rules and regulations that govern Crématoire Guenette Crematorium (hereafter known as the "Crematorium") and have been approved by the Registrar of the Funeral, Burial and Cremation Services Act 2002.

**Article 1:** Identification of the deceased shall be made prior to delivery of the deceased to the Crematorium.

**Article 2:** The regular Crematorium operating hours will be from 7 a.m. to 7 p.m., Monday to Friday. All correspondence is to be sent to 108 Byng Avenue, Kapuskasing, ON P5N 1X2

**Article 3:** Before cremation can take place, the following documents must be completed, delivered to the office or Crematorium, signed by the proper authority, and approved:

- (1) Application for Cremation
- (2) Contract to provide Cremation Services
- (3) Coroner's Cremation Certificate
- (4) Burial Permit
- (5) Payment

**Article 4:** Only human remains will be accepted for cremation. Furthermore, no extraordinary or foreign objects may be placed into the casket or cremation container.

**Article 5:** The remains of the deceased shall be received for cremation in a fully combustible casket or cremation container deemed appropriate by the Registrar. The casket/cremation container must have a top, four sides and a solid bottom allowing the casket/cremation container encasing the human remains to be moved using a set of rollers.

**Article 6:** Once received by the Crematorium personnel, the casket/cremation container will remain closed unless authorization is given by the Applicant allowing a licensed Funeral Director to open the casket/cremation container. Under no circumstances will Crematorium staff be allowed to open the casket/cremation container. The deceased will be cremated in the delivered casket/cremation container, which must be made of readily combustible materials. All non-combustible parts on the outside of the casket/cremation container, including, but not limited to casket handles and other exterior fittings, will be removed prior to cremation, if possible, and recycled.

**Article 7:** The staff of the Crematorium will not cremate a casket/container constructed of non-flammable or hazardous material or a material prohibited by the regulations under the Funeral, Burial and Cremation Services Act, 2002, of Ontario Regulation 30/11, nor will the Crematorium cremate a body in which a pacemaker or other prohibited device, material, appliance or part thereof is present. This does not limit the right to refuse to cremate, in any instance, and without specifying reasons.

**Article 8:** The staff of the Crematorium will not under any circumstances cremate an individual with radioactive implants, or an individual who has received microscopic radioactive isotope treatment, such as TheraSeed®, except if at least two years have passed since the day the body received the implant; or a lesser time has passed since the body received the implant, and it is safe to cremate the body of the recipient, as determined by the Registrar of the act. An implant heart pacemaker or other implant radioactive devices could explode during the cremation process and are to be removed by the funeral establishment, transfer service operator, or any other personnel responsible for the removal of such a device, before the deceased is delivered to the Crematorium for cremation. The Applicant of the cremation services will be liable for any damage caused to the Crematorium and/or for the injury/radiation exposure to Crematorium staff for failing to notify the funeral establishment or transfer service, or any other personnel responsible for the removal of such a device, of the existence of such radioactive implants.

**Article 9:** Twenty-four (24) hours' notice is required before a cremation can take place.

**Article 10:** Twenty-four (24) hours' notice is required if relatives and friends wish to view the cremation process. A limited number of observers will be allowed in the Crematorium before or during a cremation for an additional prescribed fee as per the current price list of services. Access can be denied by the Crematorium staff at all times. The Crematorium is a facility that provides services exclusively to funeral homes and does not provide services directly to the public.

**Article 11:** A stainless steel/metal identification tag will be placed with the deceased throughout all the stages of the cremation process; the tag shall be placed with the cremated remains into the primary urn or container at the conclusion.

**Article 12:** Due to the nature of the cremation process, no jewelry or other personal property or material will be recoverable after cremation and such property or material should be removed before the casket/cremation container is transferred to the Crematorium. Any personal property or material left in the casket/cremation container on transfer to the Crematorium shall be at the sole risk of the Applicant. The Crematorium, the funeral home, or the transfer service shall not be responsible for the loss, damage, or destruction of same.

**Article 13:** The staff of the Crematorium will not cremate the remains of more than one person at a time.

**Article 14:** All cremated human remains shall be placed in a sealed, plastic container, provided without additional charge by the Crematorium, or purchased by the Applicant and/or the family of the Deceased. In the event that any such container supplied will not hold all the cremated remains, an additional temporary plastic container will be supplied by the Crematorium without additional charge.

**Article 15:** Where and when possible, the Crematorium may provide, at its discretion, expedited services outside of regular business hours for an additional prescribed fee as per the current price list of services.

**Article 16:** Cremated remains will be returned to out of town funeral establishments by means of the ONR Bus system and the cost will be included in the cremation fee. Under no circumstances will the Crematorium ship cremated remains outside of its service area by any other means. This would be the responsibility of each funeral establishment.

## PAYMENT, FINANCING & FUNDING

### For services at time of death:

Salon Funéraire Guenette Funeral Home Inc. requires a deposit equivalent to 50% of the funeral service contract at the time arrangements are made. We reserve the right to demand full payment prior to the services and supplies being delivered. Unless otherwise specified, the balance is due within 30 days of signing the funeral service contract. We will charge interest at the rate of 2.0% per month beyond this period of 30 days, which is equivalent to 24% per annum. Payment may be made by cash, cheque, bank draft, debit, or e-transfer. Payment made by credit card will be subject to a 2% processing fee.

Salon Funéraire Guenette Funeral Home Inc. does not extend credit or financing. If you wish to pay by means of a long-term payment plan, you must make arrangements with a financial institution. We will apply administrative fees of \$25.00 for any cheque returned by a financial institution due to non-sufficient funds (NSF). The purchaser shall have to reimburse all costs associated with the collection of amounts payable. Financial assistance for funeral, burial, and cremation services is available through certain governmental agencies, for those who qualify.

### Pre-payment in advance of need:

For services that are being arranged pre-need, we offer two funding options when prepaying services or supplies:

**Trust:** You pay for the services and supplies at today's price and we will place your money in a trust account, where it will accrue interest until the prepaid contract is fulfilled (when the services and supplies are delivered). Pre-payment can be made by pre-authorized debit (void cheque). Funds are held in the purchaser's name.

**Insurance:** You may purchase an insurance or annuity policy through us, where the proceeds of the insurance / annuity policy will be used to pay for the services or supplies at the time they are delivered. Payment may be made by cheque for single payments. Time payment plans may be made by pre-authorized debit (void cheque). The policy is held in your name and assigned to the funeral home. Terms and conditions and cancellation policies are set by the Insurance Company.

**Guarantee:** When paid in full in accordance with the payment terms set out in the prepaid contract, the prepaid contract is guaranteed. The total payment(s) made plus interest / growth earned will be applied to the future price of the services and supplies. If the total payment(s) plus interest / growth earned are insufficient to cover the total future price of the prepaid services and supplies, we will absorb the difference as a loss. Any funds in excess of the total future price of the prepaid services and supplies will be returned or applied toward additional services, supplies and disbursements purchased at the time of need, as applicable. Conditions apply. Any changes to the prepaid contract may result in the prepaid contract being null and void and a new contract being executed with current pricing at the time changes are made.
