Parish Pastoral Council

Provides input to pastor and helps in setting goals for our parish.

Stewardship Council

Assists pastor in promoting stewardship in our parish.

Finance Council

Assists pastor and parish manager with parish finances.

Adult Enrichment Committee

Building & Grounds Committee

An organization of Catholic men and women who pray and support religious vocations.

Music Ministry

Provide music for weekend Masses and other special events in our parish.

Eucharistic Adoration

Opportunity for prayer with the Precious Body exposed from Thursday, 9:30 to Friday, 8:30 am.

Rosary Leader

Parishioners volunteer to lead the rosary before the Sunday, 8:30 am Mass.

Prayer Chain (email)

Parishioners volunteer to be notified whenever someone requests prayers.

Rosary for Peace

Group of parishioners pray rosary in church on Saturday mornings at 9:00 am.

Prayer Partner

Parishioners volunteer to pray for someone who is preparing to receive a Sacrament.

Ministry of Praise

Older parishioners volunteer to pray for needs that Fr Maus gives to them each month.

Transportation Assistance

Parishioners provide transportation to a weekend Mass for someone needing a ride.

**Eucharistic Ministers to Homes, Hospital, Nursing Homes, Assisted Living Facilities;
Word/Communion Service Leader at Assisted Living Facilities:**

Parishioners take communion to parishioners who are unable to attend the weekend Masses or they lead or assist at communion services at nursing homes and assisting living facilities.

Food Pantry

Volunteers help with putting food on the shelves, and others help with giving the food out to those coming to the pantry for food.

Greeter at Funerals

Assist funeral guests.

Caring Hands

Parishioners provide meals to a family with a new baby. Sometimes also help parishioners who needs a meal.

Compassion Ministry

Parishioners provide paper and plastic products to families who have lost a loved one.

Liturgical Ministries

Assist Pastor as Eucharistic minister, usher, altar server and reader.

Church Decorating

Parishioners decorate our church for Advent/Christmas and Lent/Easter.

Faith Formation

Many parishioners help in providing education to our young parishioners.

Fellowship Servers

Parishioners serve donuts, coffee and juice after the Sunday morning Masses.

BRCS Scrip Helpers
