Parish Council

Provides input to pastor and helps in setting goals for our parish.

Finance Council

Assists pastor and parish manager with parish finances.

Stewardship Council

Assists pastor in promoting stewardship in our parish.

Adult Bible Study

Adult studies during Advent and Lent

Altar Society

Serves funeral lunches and provides lunches or other services as needed in the parish.

BRCS Scrip Helpers

Parishioners sell scrip for our Catholic School after each of the weekend Masses.

Building & Grounds Committee

Assists parish manager in decisions regarding buildings and grounds repairs & upkeep.

Building and Grounds Maintenance

Volunteers to help with vacuuming, cleaning, electrical work, plumbing, carpentry, snow removal.

Capital Campaign

Financial contributions to pay for the expansion and remodel of the parish buildings.

Caring Hands

Parishioners provide meals to a family with a new baby. Sometimes also help a parishioner who needs a meal.

Catechesis of the Good Shepherd

Faith formation program for ages 4 through 1st grade.

Catholic Daughters of the Americas

A Catholic women's service organization.

Catholic Enrichment Group

An organization of Catholic men and women who pray and support religious vocations.

Charismatic Prayer Group

Prayer is the response of the Holy Spirit dwelling in us.

Children's Liturgy of the Word (CLOW)

Children (kindergarten to grade 5) receive opportunity to hear readings and gospel (during the 10:30 am) Mass in a simplified manner and do a lesson that pertains to the reading.

Compassion Ministry

Parishioners provide paper and plastic products to families who have lost a loved one.

Eucharistic Adoration

Opportunity for prayer with the Precious Body exposed in our Blessed Sacrament Chapel from Thursday, 9:30 to Friday, 7:30 am.

Eucharistic Minister Outreach

Eucharistic Ministers who take communion to homes, hospital, nursing homes, assisted living facilities for those unable to attend the weekend Masses, also may lead Word/Communion Service at assisted living facilities in our parish area.

Faith Formation

Parishioners help in providing education to our young parishioners.

Families Serving Families

Parish families serving together to help with parish events.

Fellowship Server Schedule

Parishioners serve donuts, coffee and juice after the Sunday morning Masses.

Food Pantry

Volunteers help with putting food on the shelves, and others help with giving the food out to those coming to the pantry for food.

Funeral Ministry

Assist families in preparing funeral services for their deceased loved ones.

Knights of Columbus

Men's organization in our parish which serves monthly breakfast and assists pastor as needed.

Liturgical Environment

Parishioners decorate our church for the liturgical seasons.

Liturgy Ministry Training

Instruct new and returning Liturgical Ministers in their ministries.

Liturgy Ministry Schedule

Puts Liturgical Ministry schedule together. Updated weekly in the bulletin and ministry cover.

Men of the Cross

An organization of Catholic men who evangelize other Catholic men through one-on-one contact.

Men's Group

Time of fellowship and study for parish men (first Saturday of each month)

Ministry of Praise

Older parishioners volunteer to pray for needs that Fr Maus gives to them each month.

Music Ministry

Provide music for weekend Masses and other special events in our parish.

Newsletter

Parishioners can provide articles and pictures for our newsletter.

Office Helper

Parishioners volunteer to help with mailings, bulletins, and other needs in our parish office.

Pastoral Care Committee

Provide care for parishioners in our parish.

Pray and Play

A women's time of fellowship through prayer and playing board games and cards.

Prayer Chain (email)

Parishioners volunteer to be notified whenever someone requests prayers.

Prayer Partner

Parishioners volunteer to pray for someone who is preparing to receive a Sacrament.

Respect Life Committee

Leader Needed

Educates about and promotes reverence that is due to every human life.

OCIA (Adult Formation)

Preparing adults to become Catholic or receive sacraments not received when younger.

Rosary for Peace

Group of parishioners meet in Blessed Sacrament Chapel to pray rosary on Saturday mornings at 9:00 am.

Rosary Leader Schedule

Parishioners volunteer to lead the rosary before the Sunday, 8:30 am Mass.

Seven Sisters Apostolate

Women parishioners commit to praying an hour a week on a designated day for a priest, bishop, seminarian

St. Joseph Workshop

Parishioners using their skills and talents to help other parishioners with needs.

Transportation Assistance

Parishioners provide transportation to a weekend Mass for someone needing a ride.

Summer Bible study for children ages 5-completed grade 5.
