It sure was good to be able to meet again. We had four new men join our ranks. Thanks to Francis and Jose C. Brian who are working on an exemplification soon.

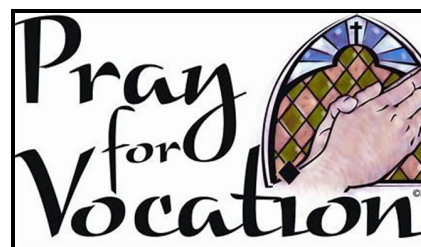
Our turn for the perpetual Rosary for vocations is July 31 and August 1st. Please help by offering a Rosary on those days
