There were over 267 Knights in attendance to represent 90 councils and 13,400 Brother Knights in North Dakota. Over the past year the ND KofC councils have donated over \$1.7 million and 397,000 hours, I always find this impressive.

Please be aware, we are working to changing the name of our Council. The resolution was read at the Meeting in April per the Laws and Rules of the order. Below is that resolution.

Resolution to Change the Name of Church of the Little Flower Council No. 1150

WHEREAS, the members of Church of the Little Flower Council No. 1150, Knights of Columbus, located in Minot, ND, desire to adopt a new name that more fully reflects the identity, heritage, and mission of the council; and

WHEREAS, the proposed new name, "St. John the Apostle Council," has been prayerfully considered and is believed to be fitting and appropriate for the council.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that Church of the Little Flower Council No. 1150 hereby requests approval from the State Deputy of the North Dakota State Council to officially change its name to "St. John the Apostle Council"; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that, upon approval by the State Deputy, this resolution shall be forwarded to the Supreme Secretary of the Knights of Columbus for final approval and recording.

Adopted by vote of the council on this ____ day of _____, 20____, following proper notice and readings in accordance with the Laws and Rules of the Order.

If you wish to have a vote or say in the resolution or name change, please attend the meeting to be held on May 5th at 7:00 p.m. at St. John the Apostle Catholic Church.

Our prayers are with the farmers and gardeners as they prepare their respective plantings. I will see you soon.

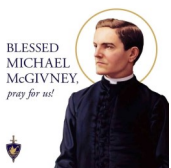
