



2026 Coaches Checklist



STEP 1: RESERVE YOUR SPOT

- Find a Team Camp that works best for you and your squad and reserve your spot by visiting fcacheer.org, as soon as you can because Camps fill up fast.
- Do not wait until tryouts to register you team!
- If your numbers of participants decrease before the start of camp, we will apply extra deposit(s) paid to the balance due.
- If numbers change, we will send you a new statement for your bookkeeper.
- Mail a deposit to hold your spot.
- Address: FCA Cheer, 3001 Monroe Hwy, Suite 400A, Bogart, GA 30622
- Total deposit due: \$100 per each cheerleader and coach attending camp
- Note: if we do not receive a deposit, your spot will not be reserved and the camp may fill up

The deposit is non-refundable. Full payment is due 30 days prior to the beginning of camp. Any cancellation after the 30 days will result in full retention of payment.

STEP 2: REGISTER YOUR SQUAD

- Once you reserve your spot, you will be emailed a camper registration form that will need to be filled out by each member of your squad.
- Due to legalities, each cheerleader and coach will need to individually fill out the form and have it digitally signed by an adult, parent or guardian.
- We recommend sending the registration form to each cheerleader & coach.
- An individual on your squad can not attend or participate in the camp until they have each completed the registration form!
- As the coach, it is your job to be sure that everyone has filled out the papers before they get on the bus to come to camp.

Mail in remaining balance due 30 days before the start of camp. All cancellations 30 days or less before the first day of camp will result in full payment being retained.

STEP 3: GET READY FOR CAMP

- The camp schedule and the coaches checklist is posted on our website for you to print and bring with you to camp.
- If your numbers change at any time before the start of camp, it is a requirement to let us know so that we can adequately prepare for your arrival.
- Bring a “rooming list” of your group to turn in at check-in for 2 roommates and possibly 4 suite mates depending on your dorm.
- Sideline evaluation competition. (end of day one) - one sideline that you do a total of 4 times with the first two times through being words and motions. On round 3 and 4 you can add standing tumbling, jumps stunts with a straight up liberty being the highest level of stunting.

You will receive an evaluation sheet and at the end of the competition and a prize will be given to the highest score. This sideline evaluation is optional but encouraged.

GENERAL INFORMATION

- Registration is from 9:00am until 11:00am. Please come as early as possible since you will need to get moved into your room and eat lunch (on your own) prior to the start of camp.
- Opening demos are at 1:00pm in the gym. **Please be on time!**
- The first meal the University will provide is dinner.
- Our amazing FCA camp store will be open on night 1 and night two. On the final day, our camp store is open in the gym for parents to shop.
- Parents, relatives and friends may enjoy watching on the last day of camp from 9:00 am – 12:00 pm in the gym.
- Only coaches and chaperones may drive on campus.
- There will be a charge for lost keys determined by the University. Please come with a check to pay for lost keys at check out. The lost key fee is the responsibility of your school.
- To be fair, please do not post video of camp material to social media. Other teams will be going to other camps after your camp. We want them to enjoy the same experience as your squad without having prior knowledge of the camp material.

Day Three will be a Fun Day with the theme of
Proven Loyal- Support Your Favorite Team in your clothing.
Wear your camp clothes underneath to be ready for stunt class.

WHAT TO BRING

- Bedding: twin extra long full sheets, blanket, pillow or sleeping bag
- Toiletries: shampoo, soap, hair dryers, etc.
- Towels, flip flops for shower (also an old towel to throw on the floor as a rug).
- Most squads wear matching camp clothes, but it is not required. They can also buy matching shirts at our camp store starting night one. Uniforms are often worn the last day, but again not necessary.
- Bring your pajamas and a sweatshirt also. The dorm or gym can be very cold! Bring your favorite healthy snacks and drinks.
- We will give a gift of a sling bag, Bible, journal and pen for each cheerleader and coach for the FCA huddle.
- Most campers bring money to camp for snacks and drinks (if there are vending machines), and to buy t-shirts, sweatshirts, etc. from our camp store.
- Poms, signs, megaphones & flags are encouraged if you have them
- Alarm clock
- Water bottle
- Backpack or bag to carry items back and forth from the gym
- Team first aid kit for minor issues (rub for muscles soreness and Tylenol). Our trainer is not allowed to distribute medicine!
- Please leave valuables at home. No jewelry is allowed on cheerleaders or instructors. That includes nose jewelry, belly button jewelry, etc.

Neither FCA or the University are responsible for stolen or lost items.
Cell phones are not allowed out of their bags during camp
or at our nightly fuel station.



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
