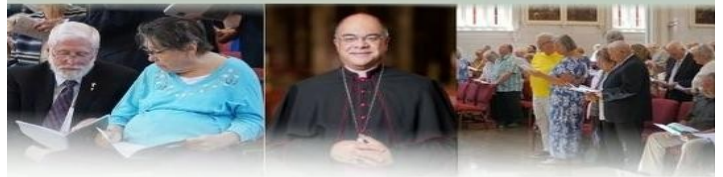

I'm also grateful and encouraged by the number of children who have signed up—or shown interest—in our proposed Young Folks Beginner Choir. As we prepare for **a new year of faith formation**, I'm happy to announce that we will again use the "A Family of Faith" program from Sophia Institute for grades outside of sacramental years. This year's focus will be on the Profession of Faith, and parents play an active role in learning and sharing the faith at home.

For children preparing for the sacraments of First Reconciliation/Communion and Confirmation, we will be using programs from Ascension Press—"Renewed: Your Journey to First Reconciliation," "Received: Your Journey to First Communion" and "Chosen: Your Journey Toward Confirmation." These excellent resources include engaging video content and a media-friendly structure that allows for more flexibility and at-home participation while still keeping us connected and on track for preparation.

Registration for all students begins the weekend of August 9–10. A Parent/Guardian Orientation will be held on Wednesday, August 27. Thank you for making faith formation a priority in your family.
